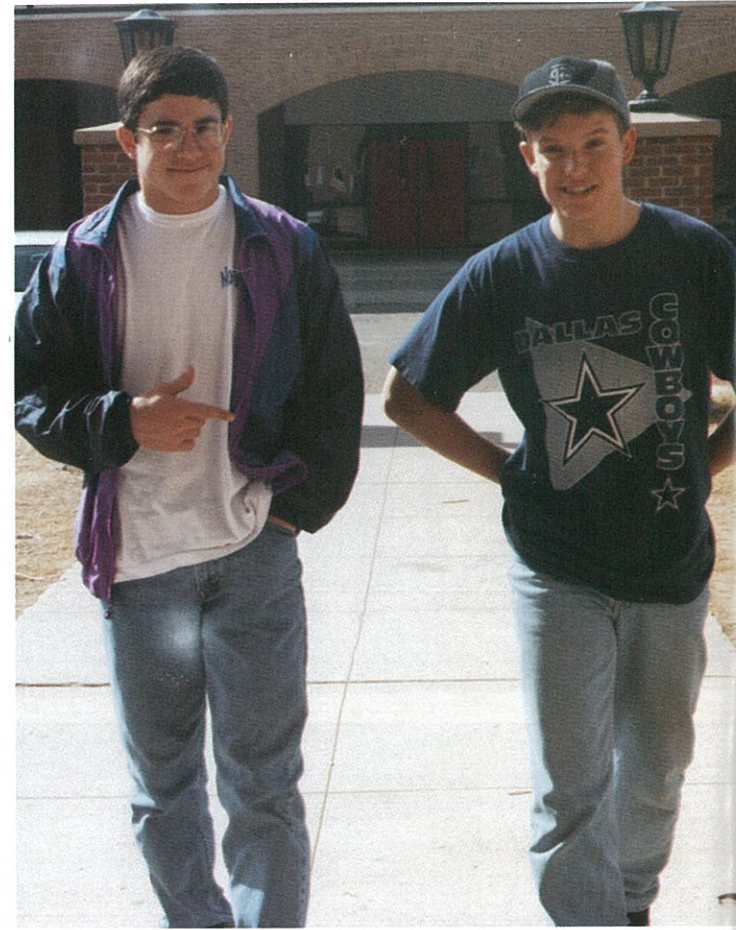


All You Really Need Are Friends

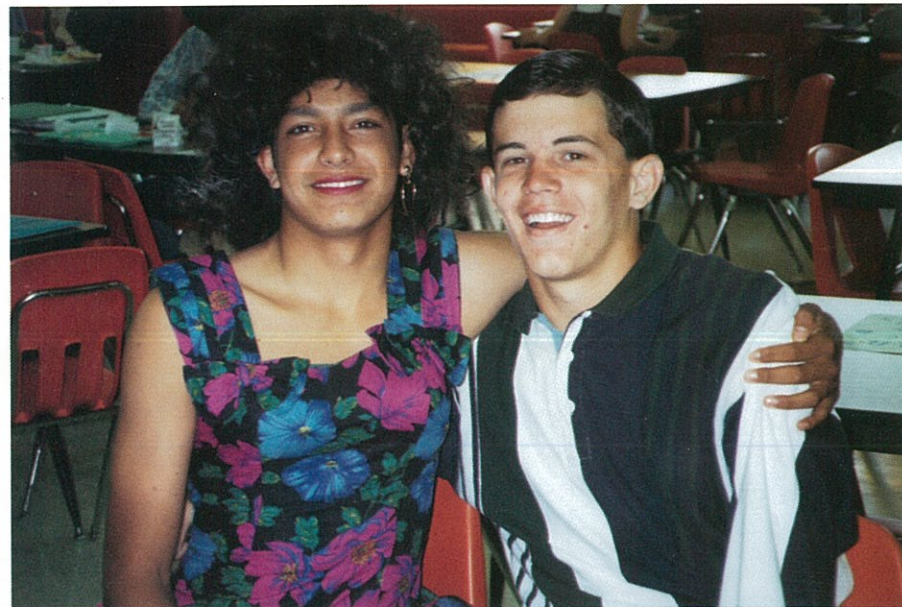
