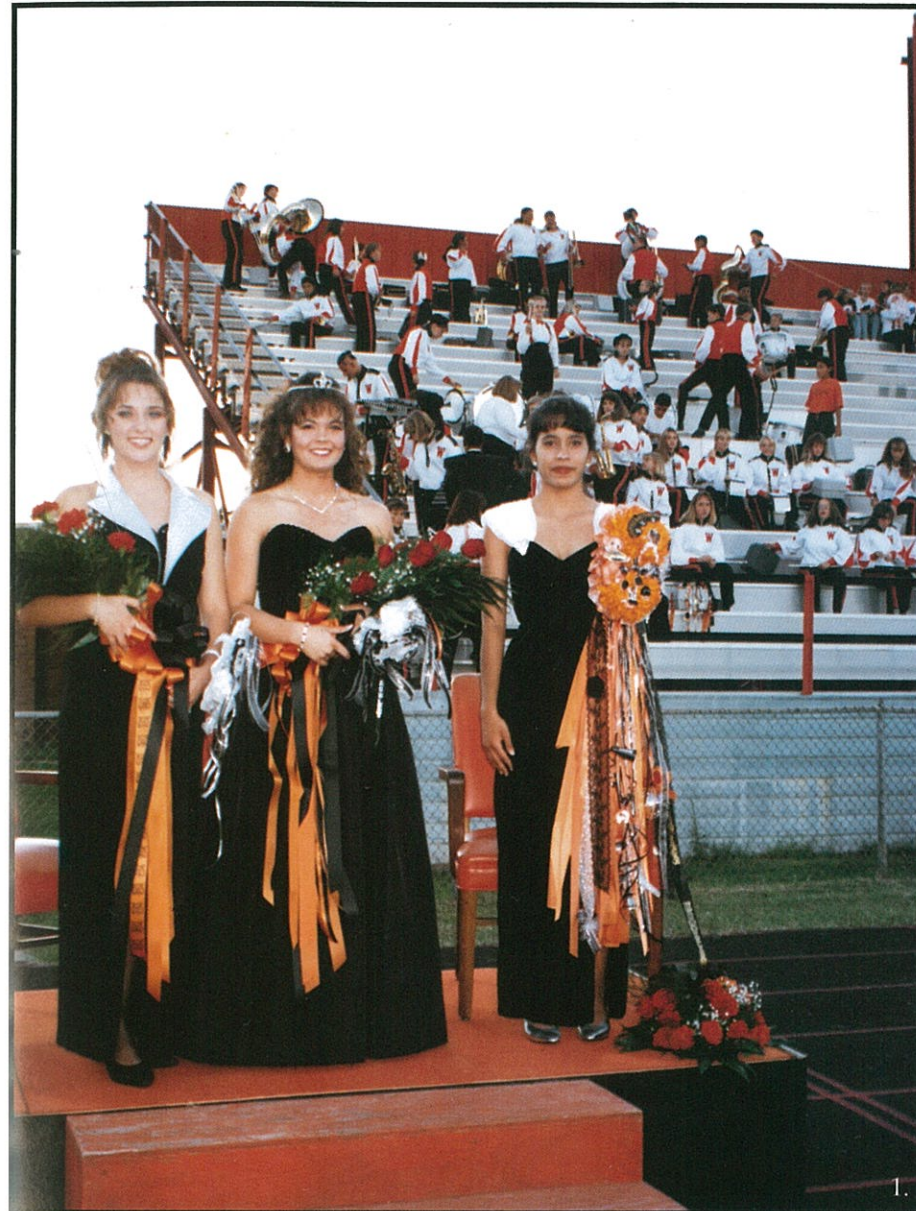
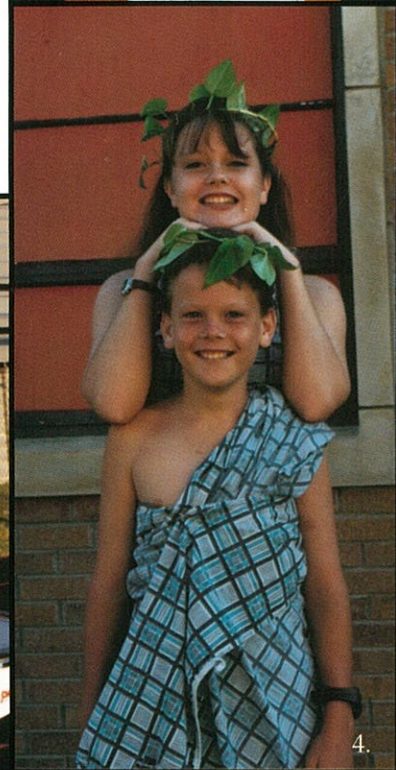


A Week of Fun . . .
