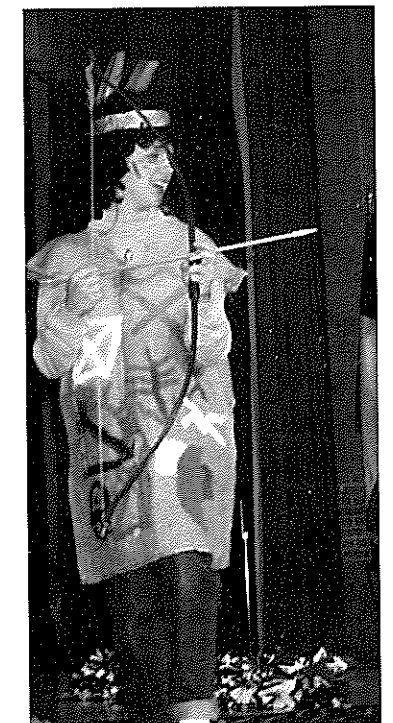
After some tense moments, Amber Robertson and Jennifer McGeehee are able to relax and cheer as the Wildcats defeat Menard in the bi-district game.
