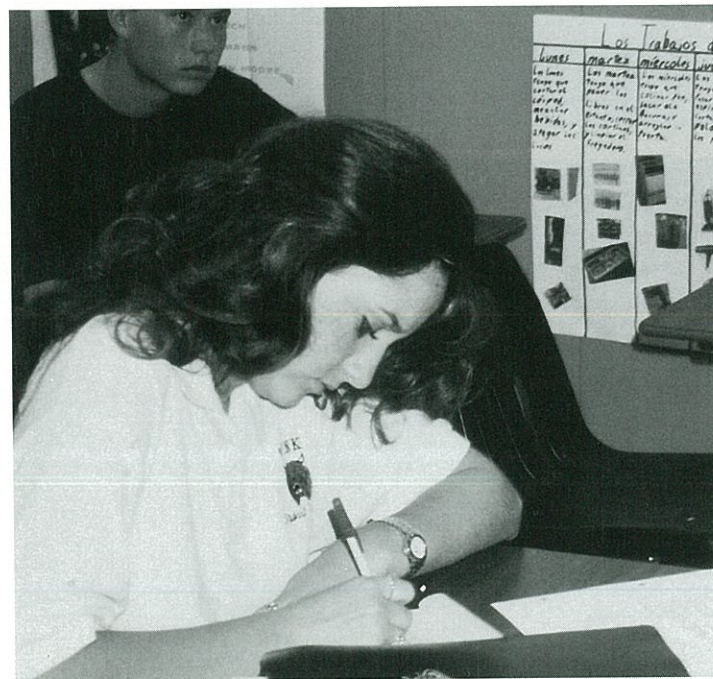

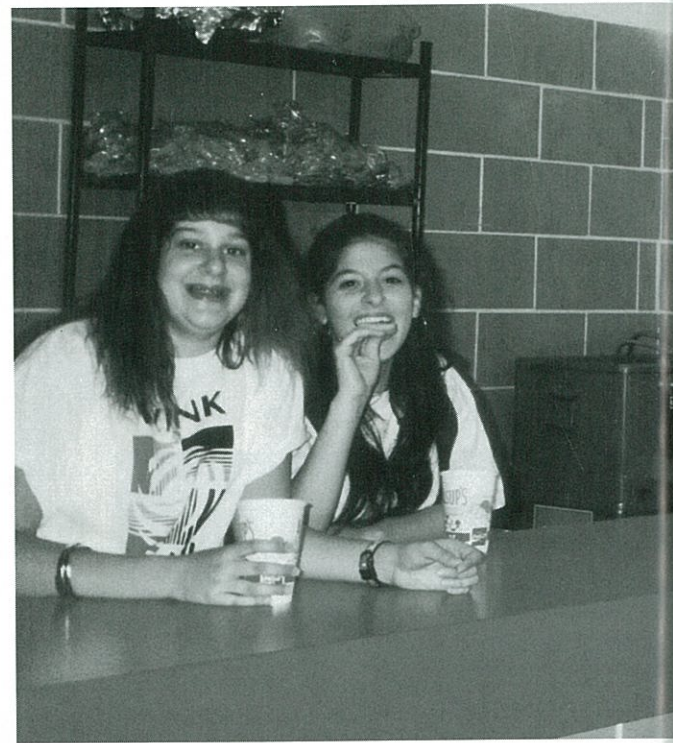
# Sweepstakes

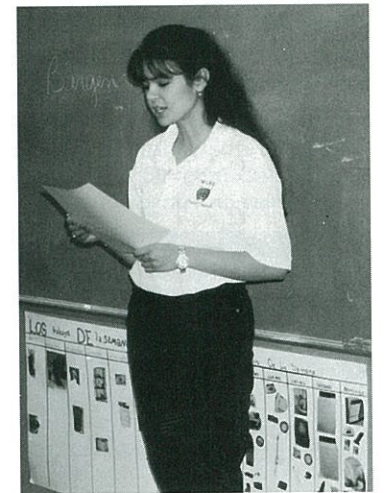
