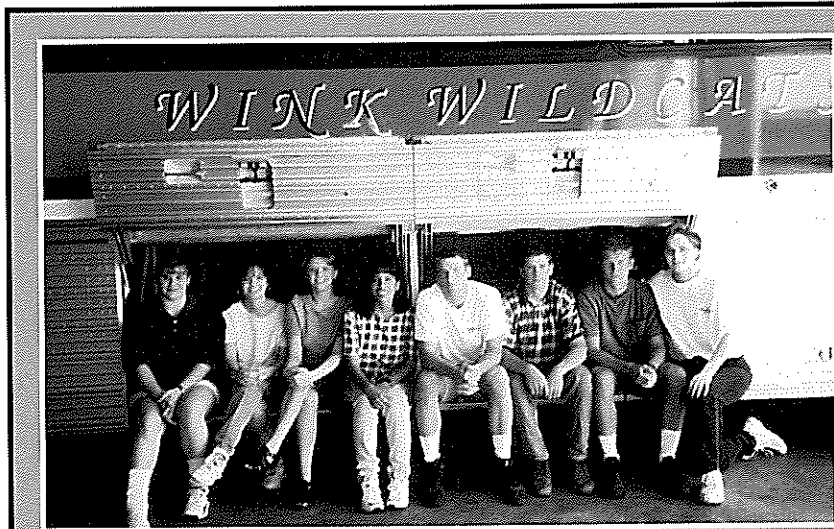


## Last Year for PALS

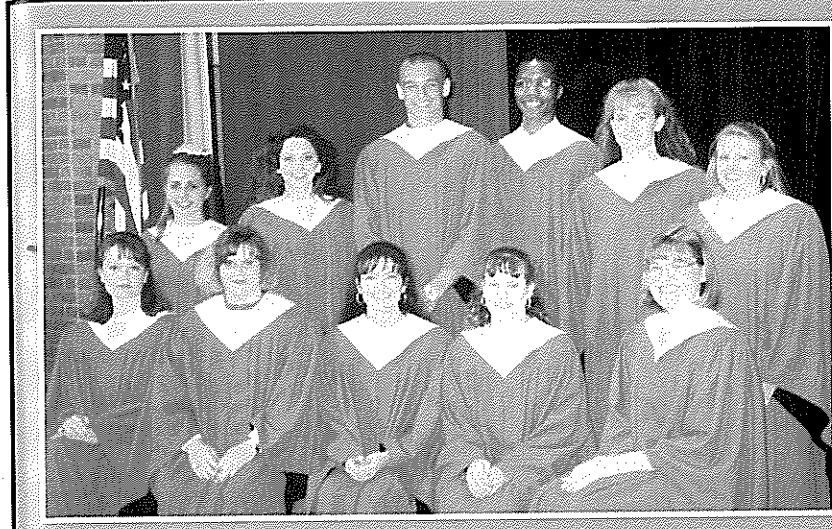
The 95-96 school year marked the fourth and final year for the Peer Assisting Leaders group since the state will no longer grant credit for the course.

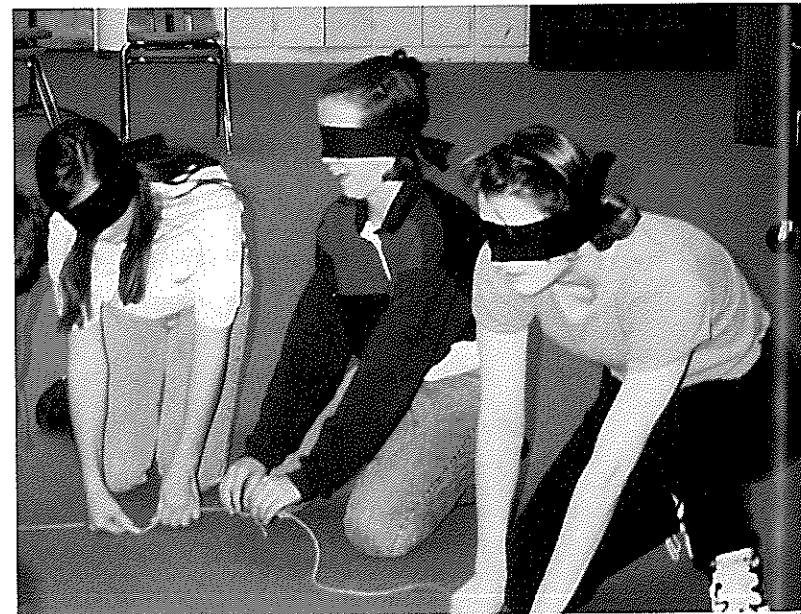
## Induction of Six Highlights NHS Year

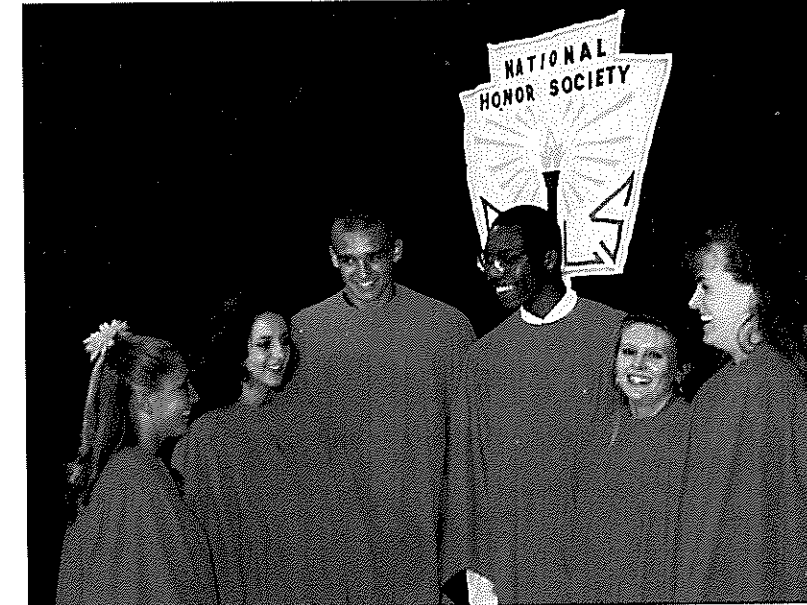
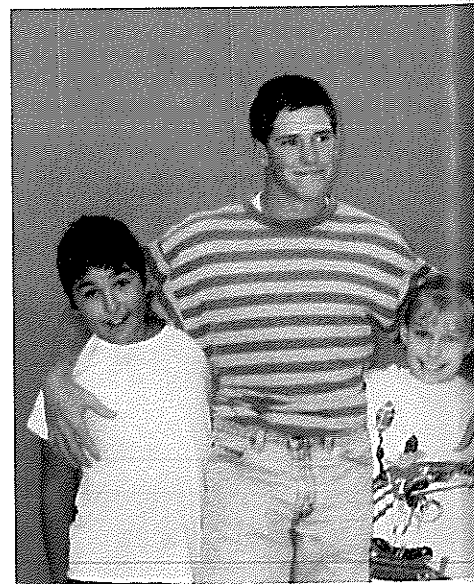
