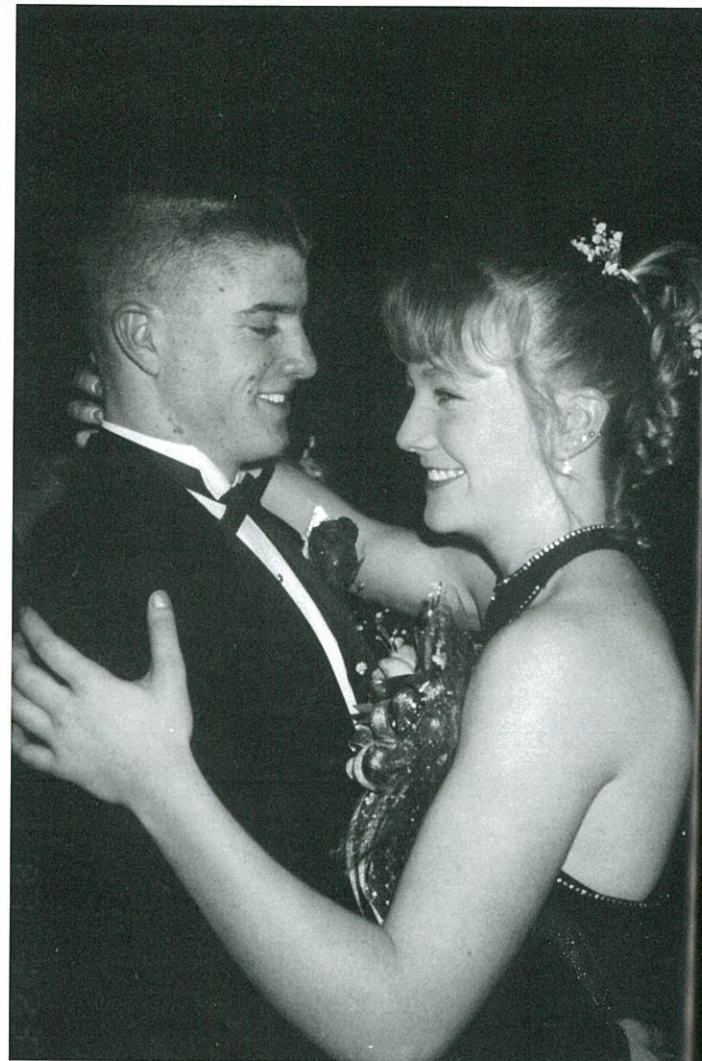
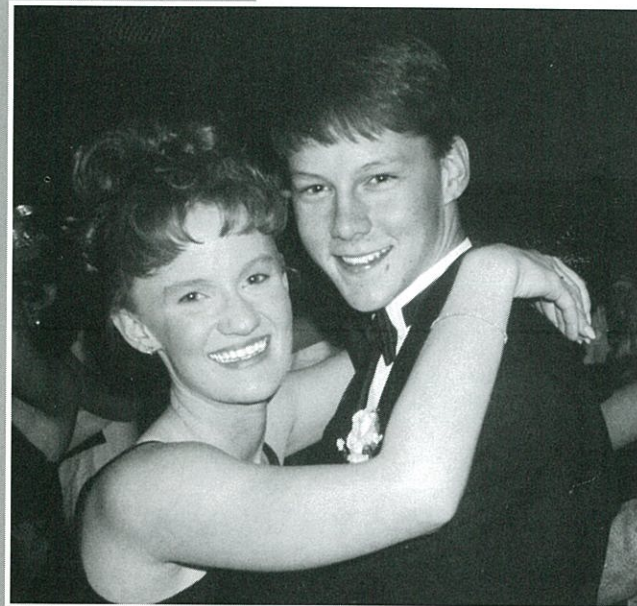


Something Special

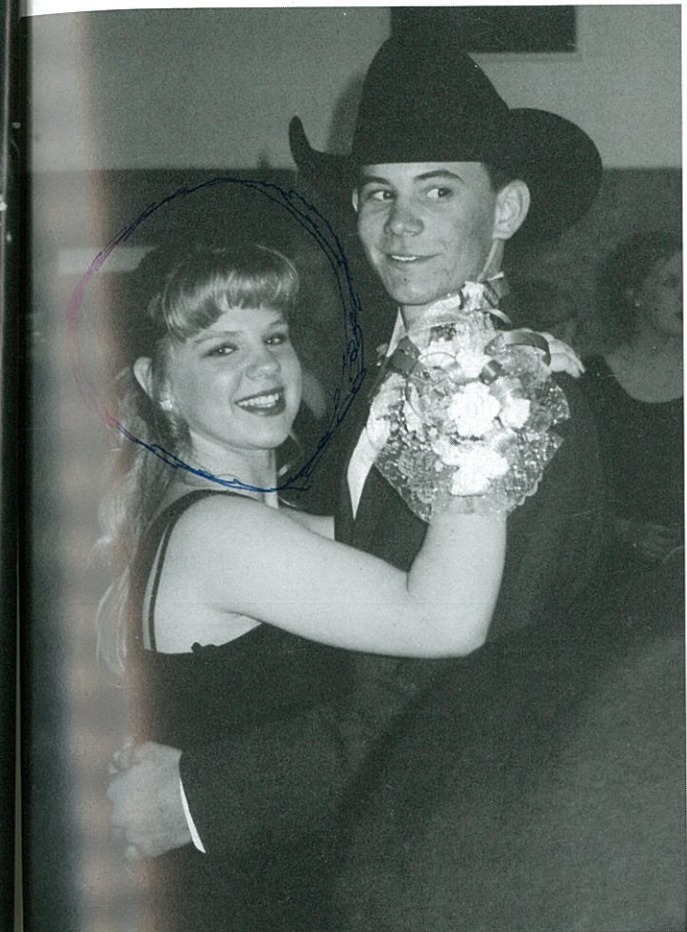

Senior Sheldon Claborn and his date sophomore Casie Slaughter enjoyed every dance.

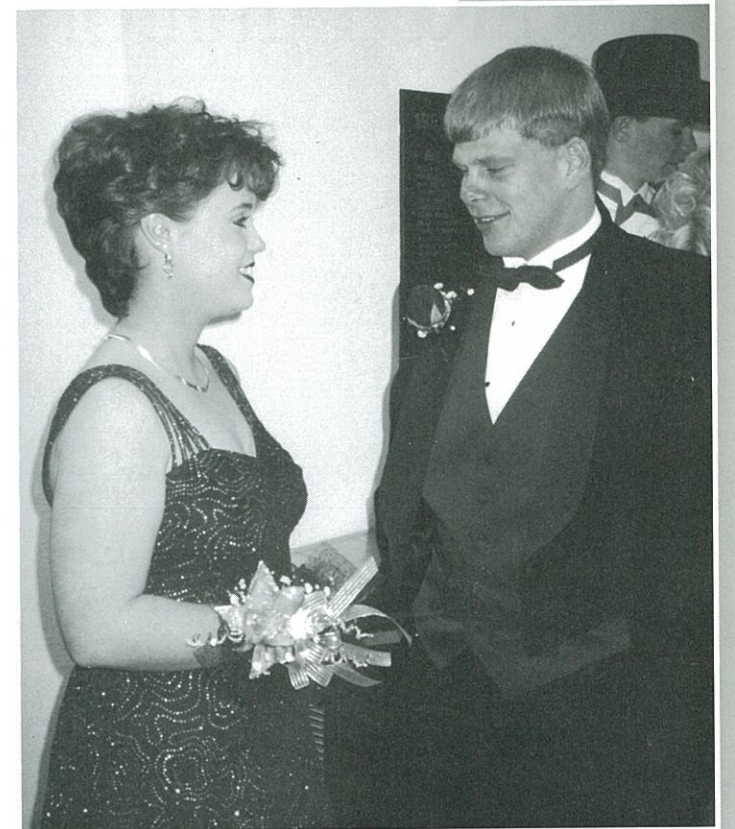
Seniors worked especially hard to make prom night a memorable occasion. Amber Connell and Stephen Treadwell agree the hours of work paid off.



Doni Clark seems to approve of Jared Green's decision to go 'western' for the night.

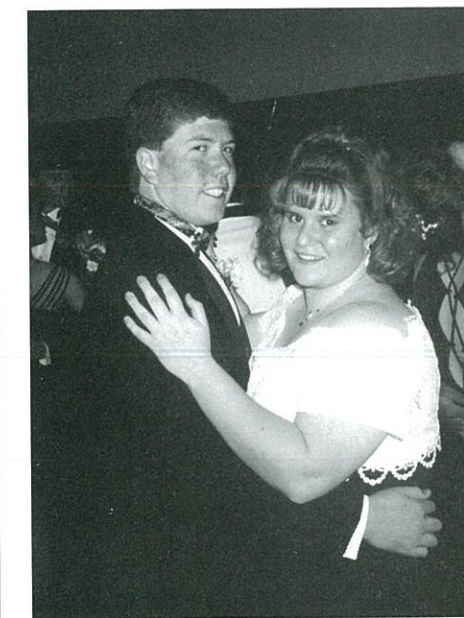
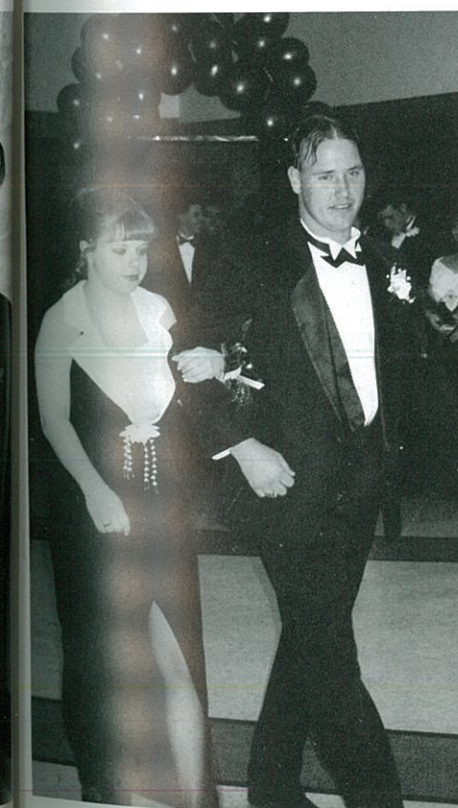
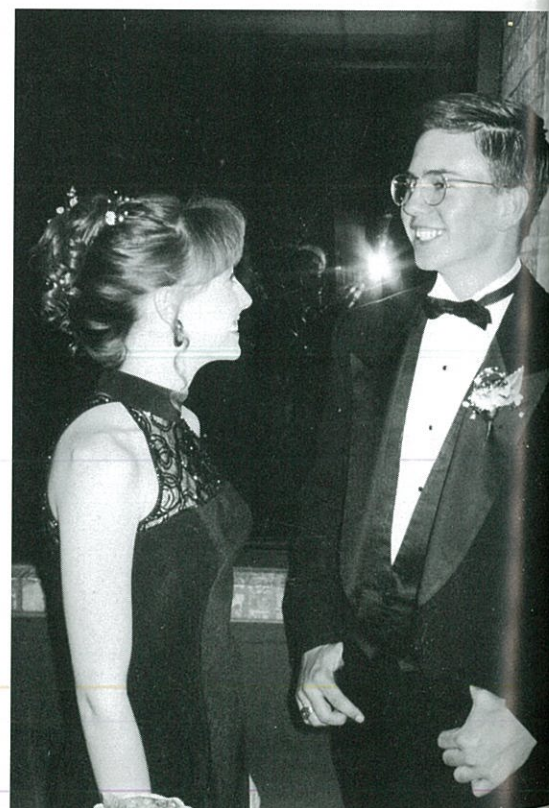


Juniors Patrisha Pipkin and P.J. Sternadel have a few minutes to talk and admire each others prom attire before the Grand March begins.

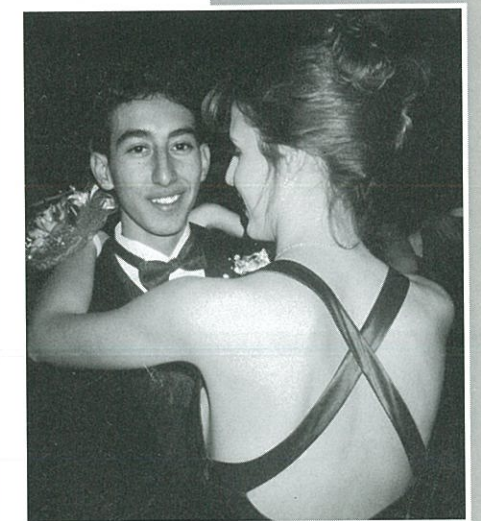


Amanda Henderson makes some last second adjustments to John Wingrove's tuxedo before they depart for the prom.
