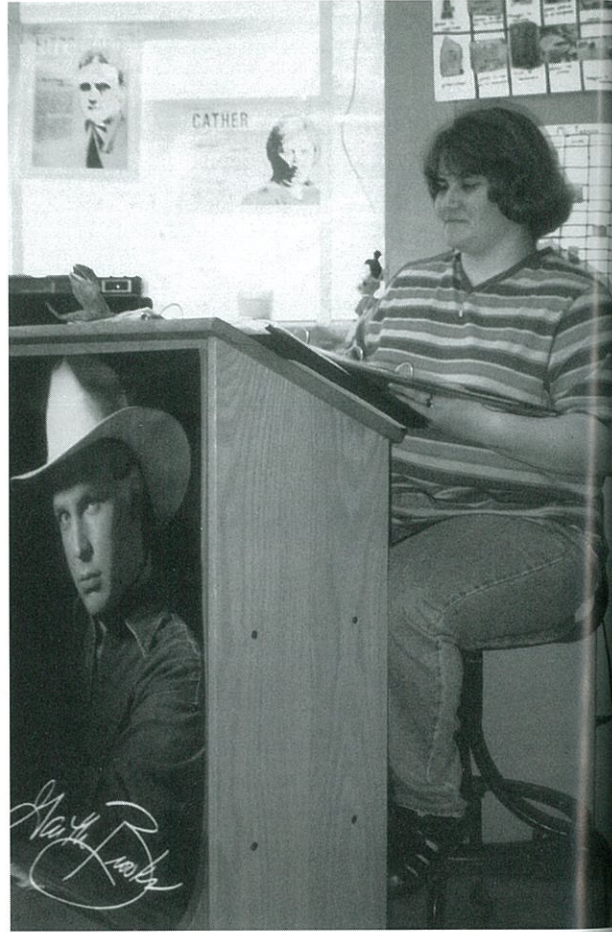
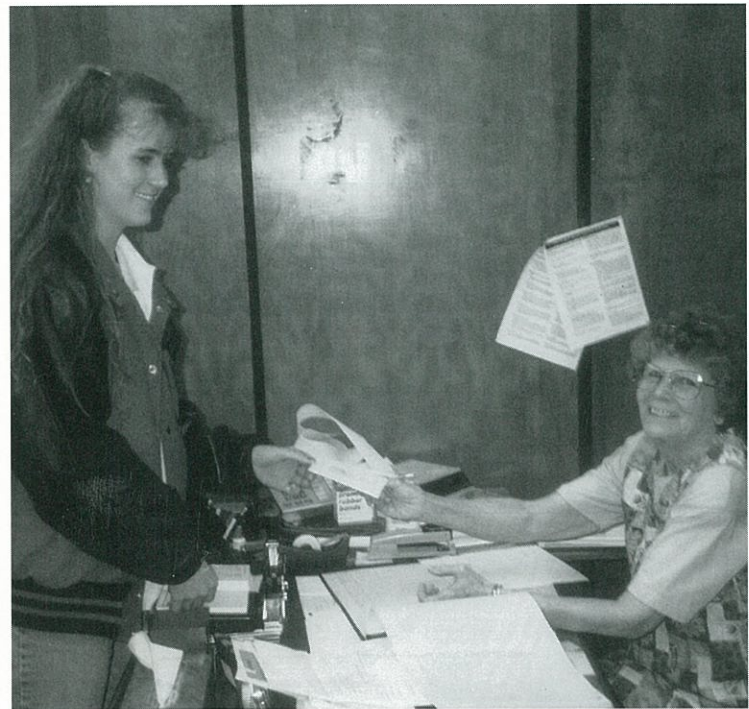


It's Our Time to Shine
