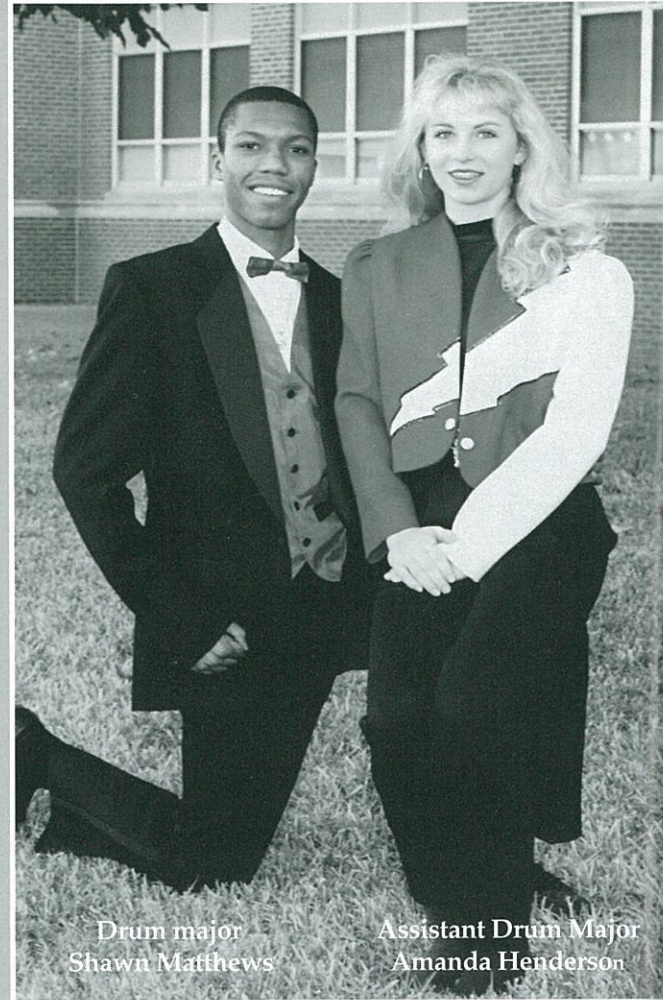

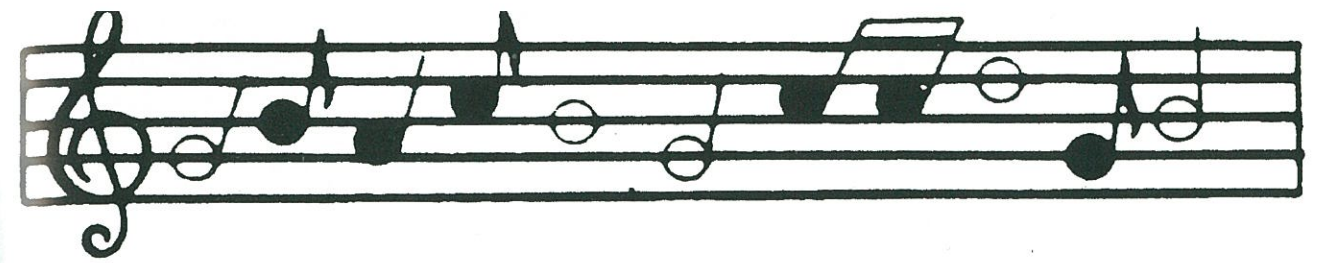

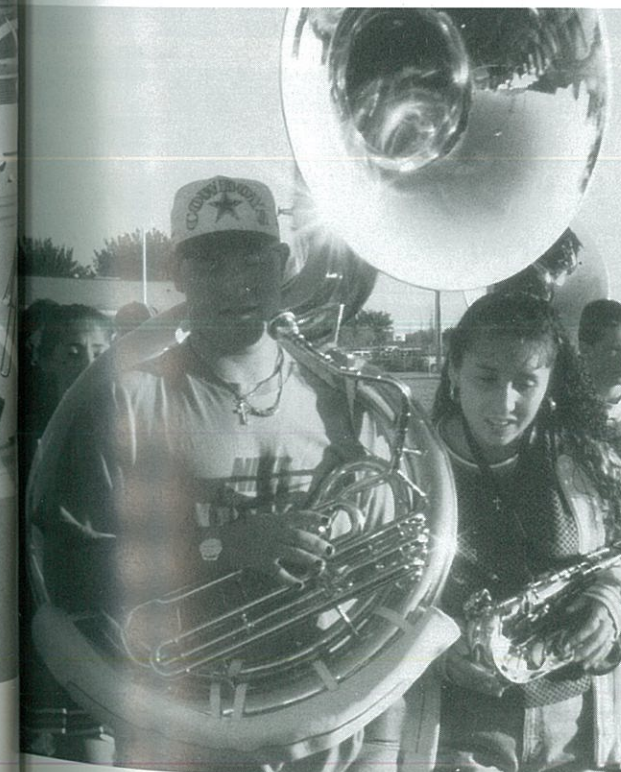
Greg Smith, flute solo. Smith also received a Division II rating for his saxophone solo.
