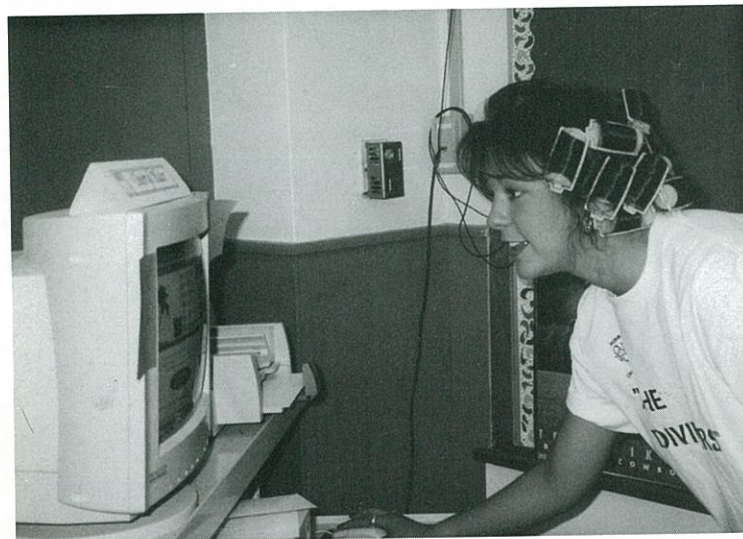


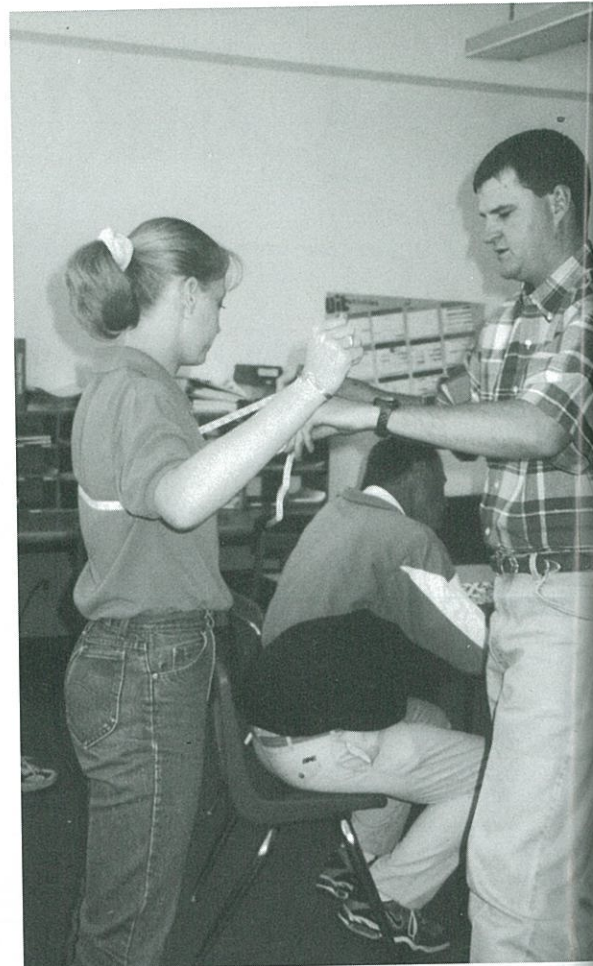
# The Pieces Fall into Place

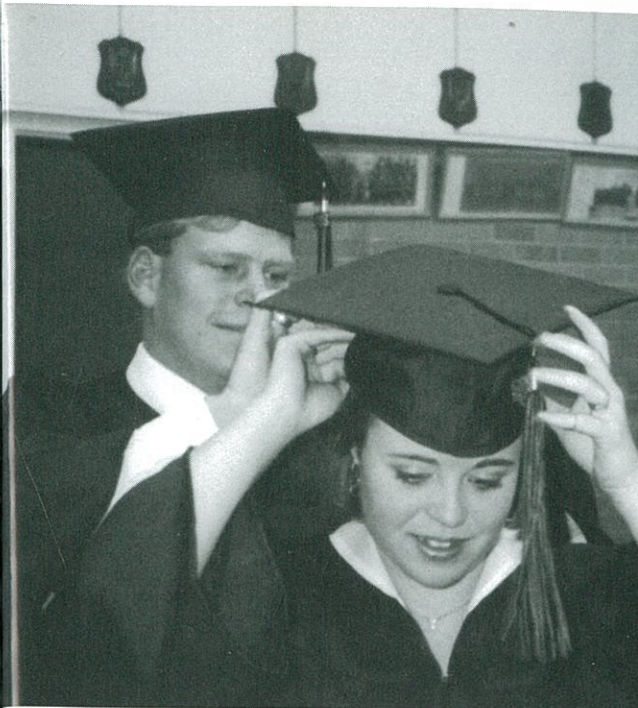


Watch out for the snow!! Shanna Dennis and Chris McCalib seem to serve as sentinels while on the band trip to Crested Butte, Colorado.

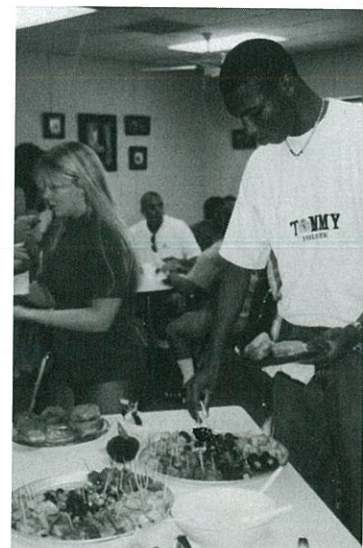


Graduation is a special time for P.J. and Patrisha Sternadel. The couple was married over the Christmas Holidays, and they are eager to continue their lives together.
