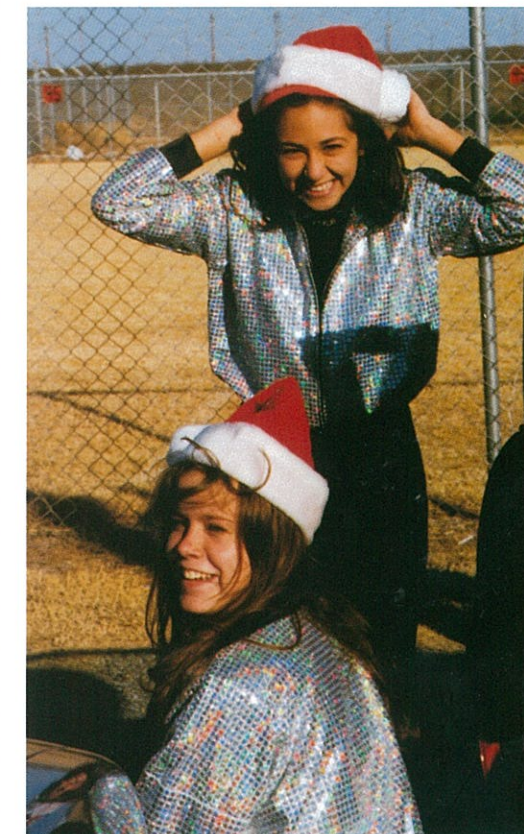


Will the pieces fit?
