

Boys Place Second at District



Eight Advance to Regionals

A young boys varsity track team finished in second place at the District Track Meet in Garden City with 163 total points.

Freshmen had a strong impact on the team with two qualifying for Regional. Ben McGehee qualified in both the 3200m and the 1600m runs, and Swen Swenson as a member of the two qualifying relay teams.

Sophomores Casey McCallister and Sam Haring qualified for Regional in the pole vault and discus respectively.

Justin Hamm and Doro Mendoza represented the junior class as members of the 1600m relay. Justin also qualified for the long jump competition.

Senior Regional qualifiers were Shawn Matthews in the 400m run and as a member of both relays and Brandon Thompson in the 400m relay.

Junior Justin Hamm runs the 110m hurdles proving that he is versatile in several track events. Justin placed sixth in the 110 hurdles at Regional and also competed in the long jump and 1600m relay. The relay finished sixth at the Regional competition.



Ever hear of holding your tongue just right? Sophomore Casey McCallister has and uses it to his advantage to win the district pole vault championship with a vault of 12'. He placed third at Regional, missing out on a trip to state on number of attempts.

Ben McGehee was a major supplier of points at the district track meet as he took first place in both the 3200m and 1600m runs. At Regional he placed fourth in the 3200 and qualified as State alternate by taking third in the 1600m.

Sam Haring placed first in the discus at District with a throw of 133'10". He finished third in the shot with a toss of 41'4".
