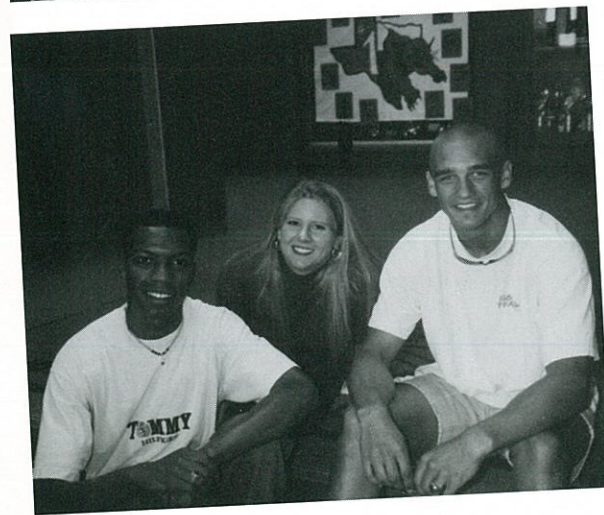
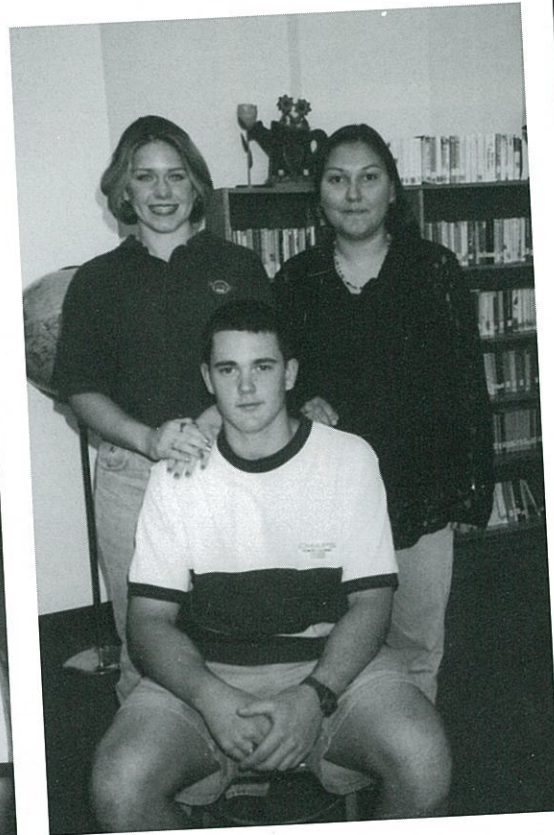


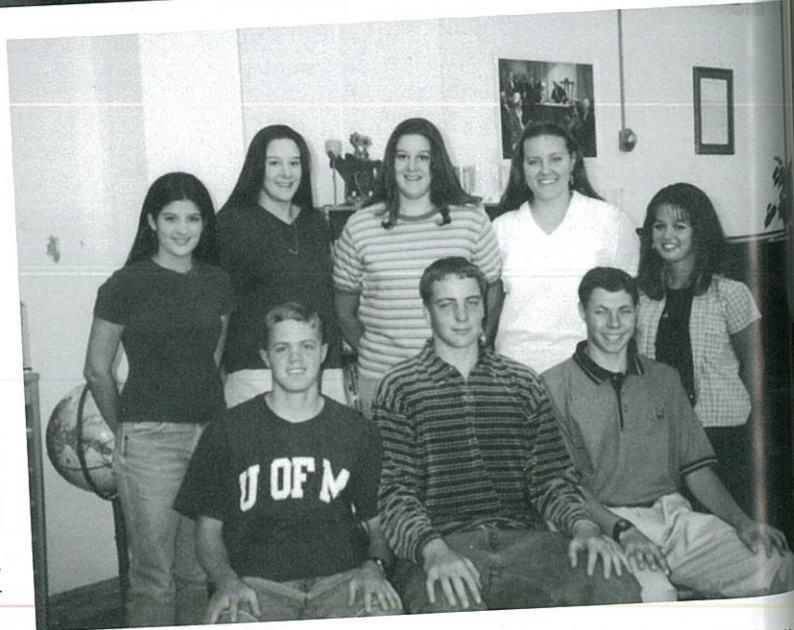
Thirteen Scholars Inducted During May Ceremony National Honor Society Doubles in Size

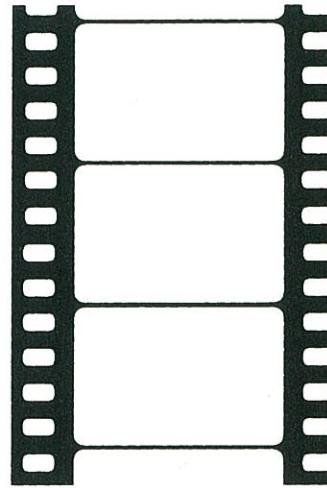
Page, after page, after page . . . The REAL Construction Crew
