

Architects of Success


WLISD is one of the premiere school districts in Texas, and the administrators and school board work hard to keep it that way.

Administrative 'Duties'


Mr. John Benham makes good his pledge to sit on the roof if the elementary school received exemplary status. He even throws candy to waiting students.
