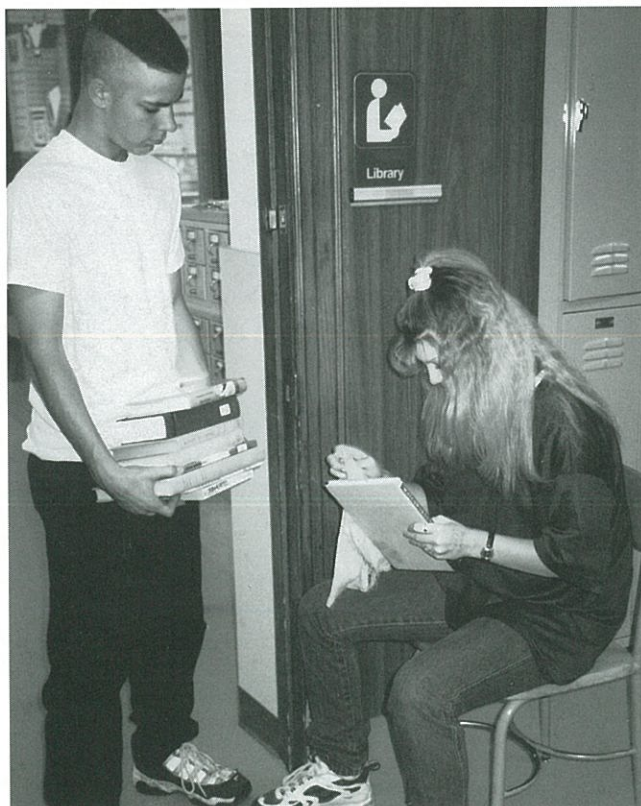
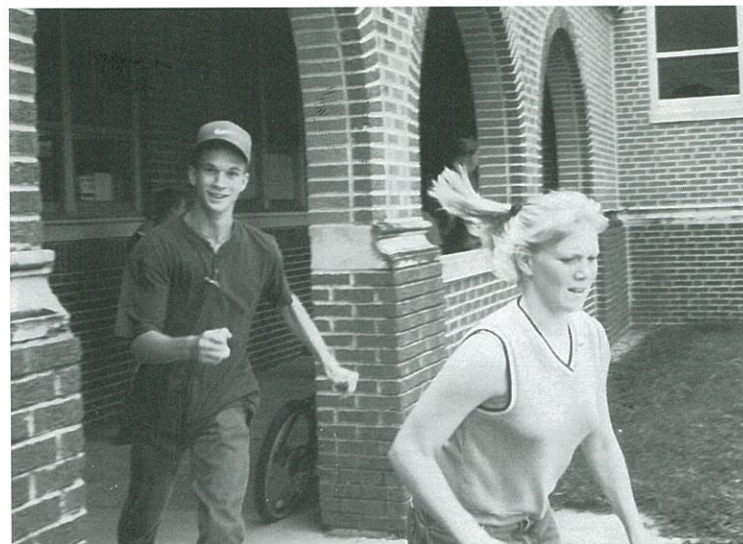


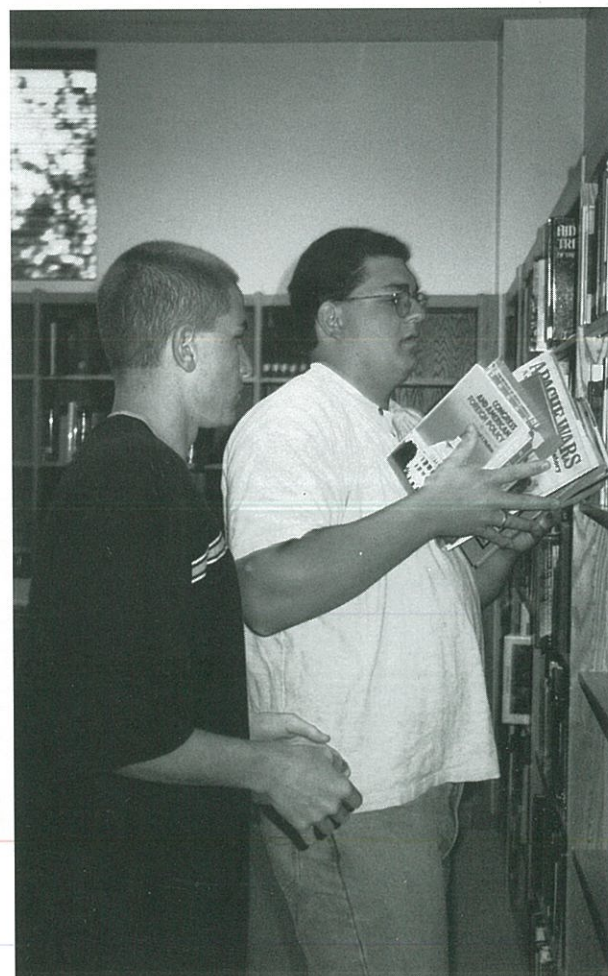
A New Library - *from beginning to end*

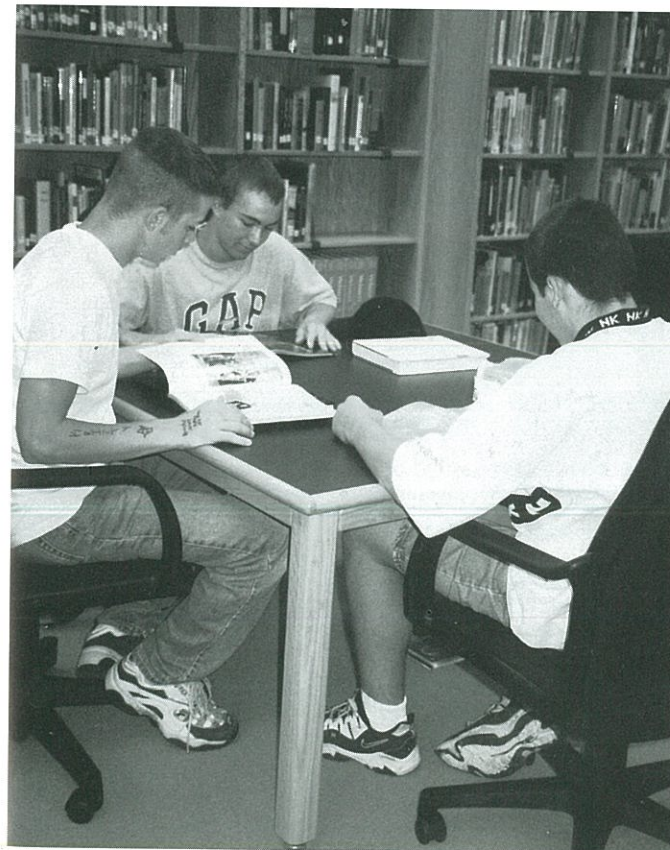

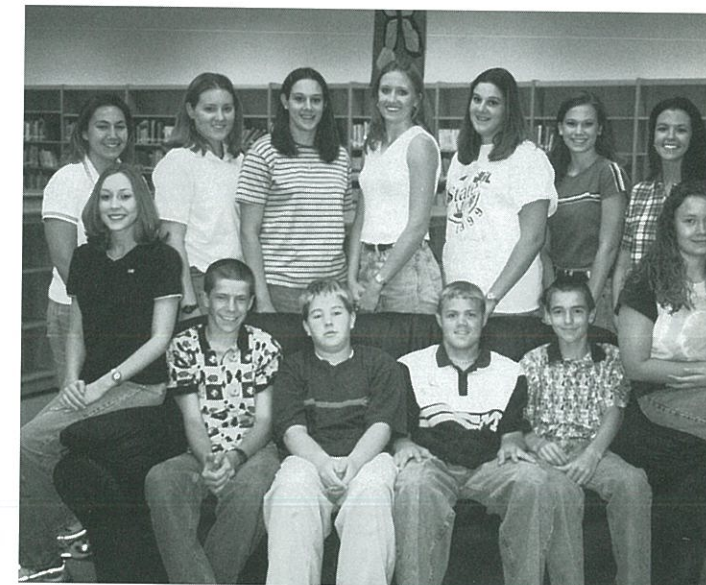
Senior Dustin Loftin makes sure books delivered by freshman Keecha Carroll are in the proper order for shelving.
