

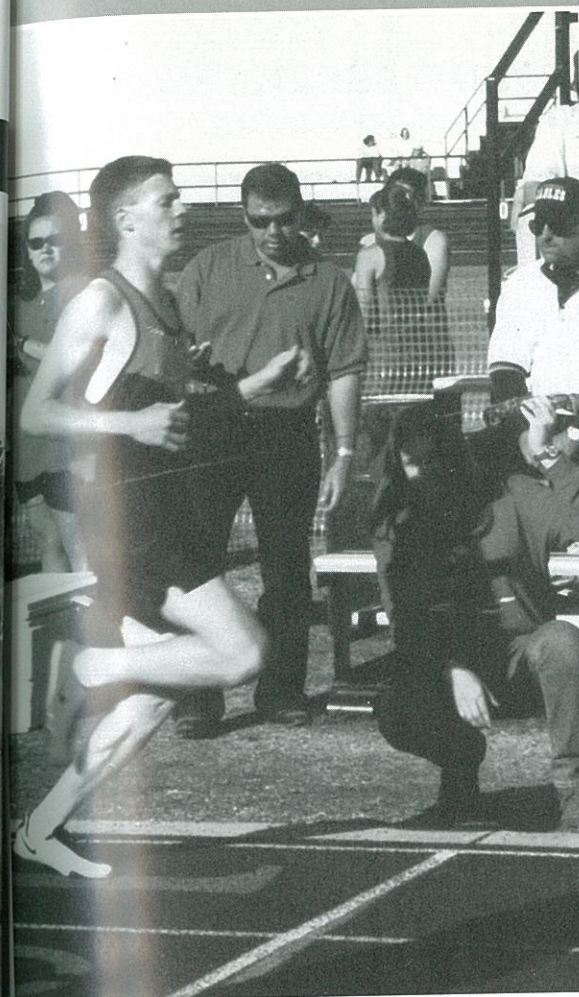
# District and Area Champions

## Team finishes third at Region I A Track Meet

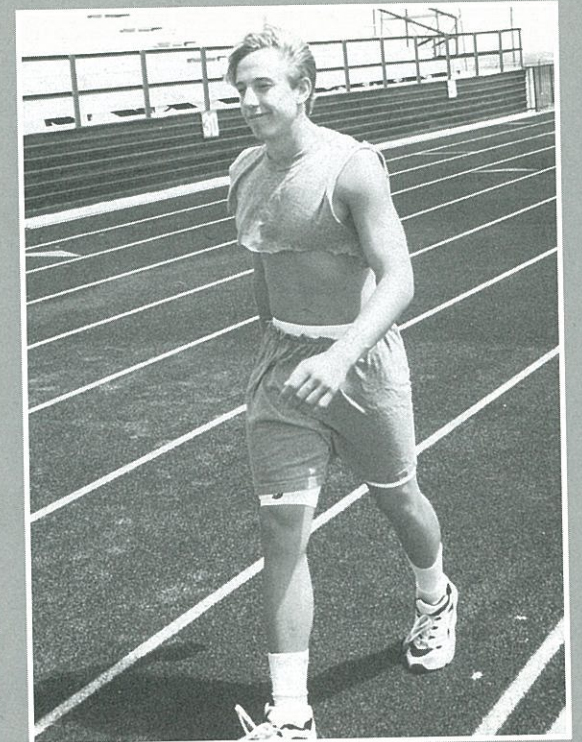
At the area track meet, senior Justin Hamm jumped 21 feet to win first and advance to the regional track meet. Justin was also the lead leg of the regional qualifying 1600m relay.



Junior Casey McCallister vaulted 14 feet at the Badger Relays in McCamey for his best height of the season. He went on to win both the district and area meets, but then, his season ended when he broke his wrist during practice on the Monday before the regional meet.



Ben McGehee won a silver medal at the State Track Meet in the 1600m run with a time of 4:31.68 narrowly missing out on first. He also competed in the 3200m run at state. Fellow sophomore Swen Swenson qualified for state in the 400m run. The two carried a great deal of weight for the track team all season. In addition to the long races, McGehee was a member of the 1600m relay as was Swenson. Swenson also qualified for regional in the 200.

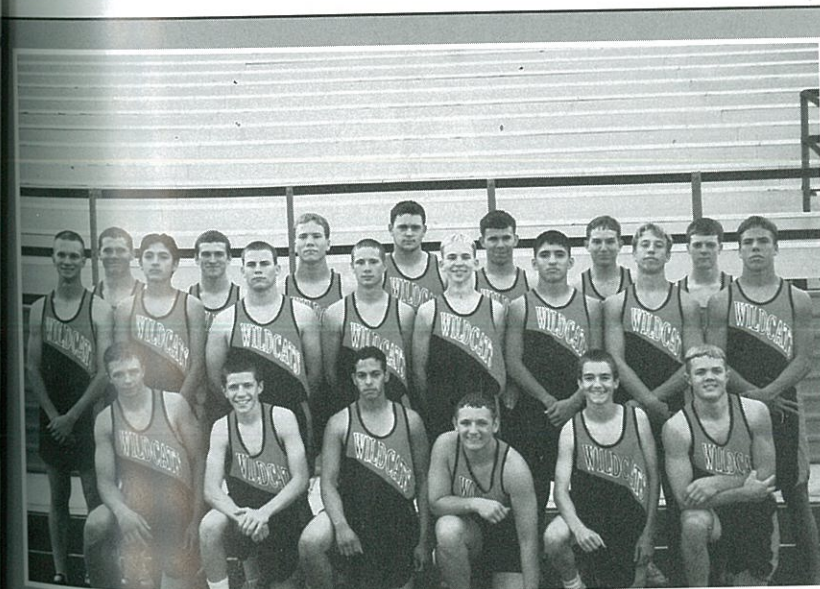


Will Haws sprints the last curve of the 400 meter run. He also ran the 200 meter run.

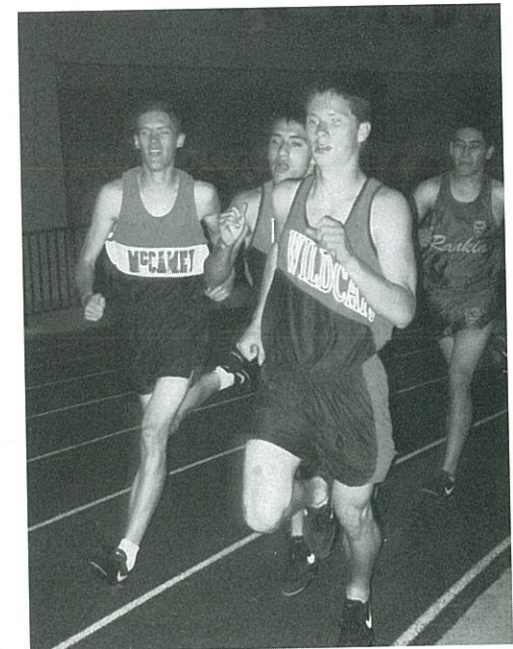


Eathan Hamm finishes the last hurdle at the Wildcat Relay. He was a member of the 1600m relay that advanced to regional.
