
Going Back in Time Halftime show features songs from the '60s

Sophomore Kevin Benham shows support for both his country and his school as he takes part in the pre-game festivities, which include playing the national anthem and school fight song on his trombone.


Senior Michael Berta provides musical ability and leadership for the Baad Cat Band. In his fifth year with the marching band, he fills the position of first cornet.
