

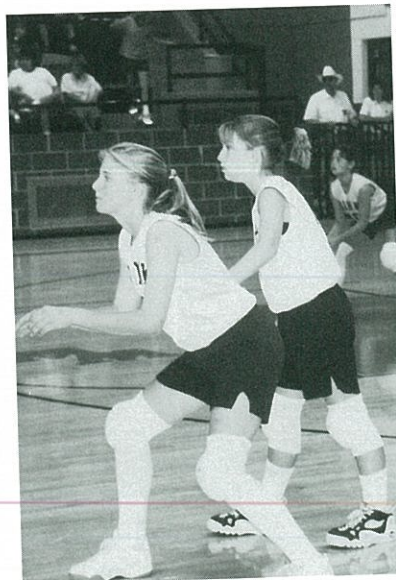
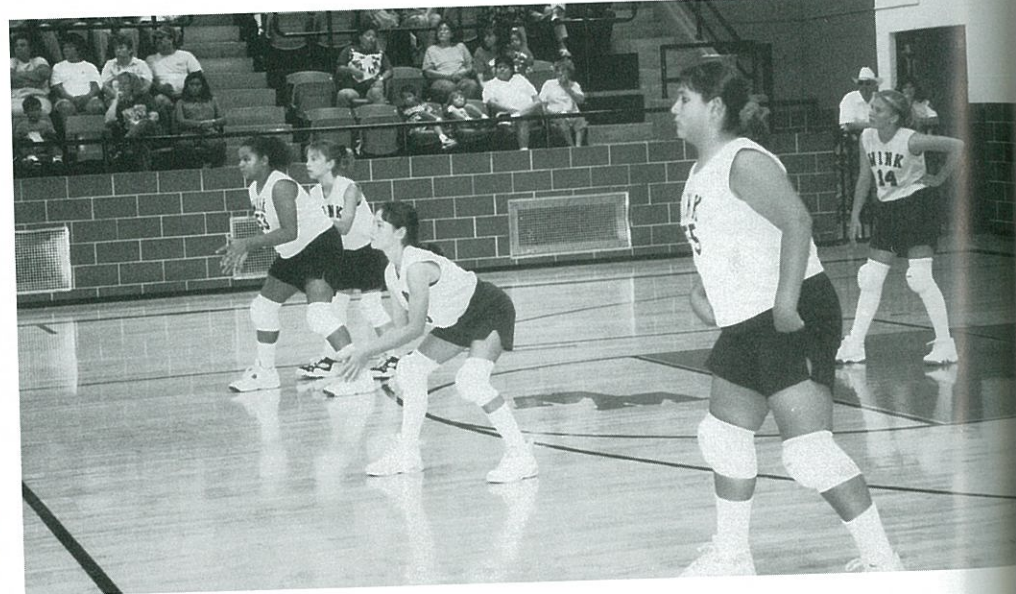
# Preview of Coming Attractions

After winning a game, seventh graders Reva Hernandez, Kristin Jacquez, Sierra Ancira and Brittni Jamison join in the "victory yell."

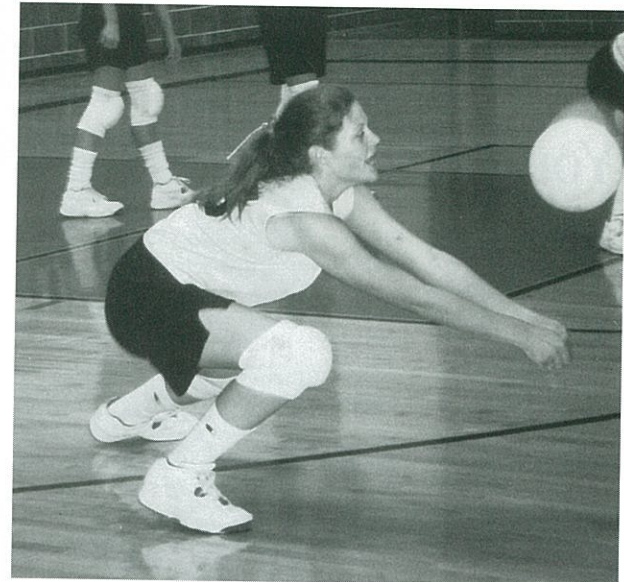
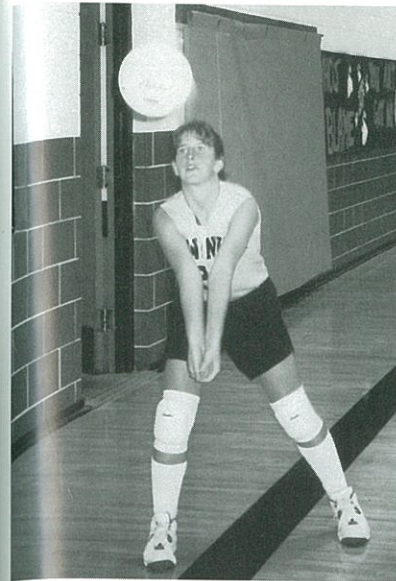

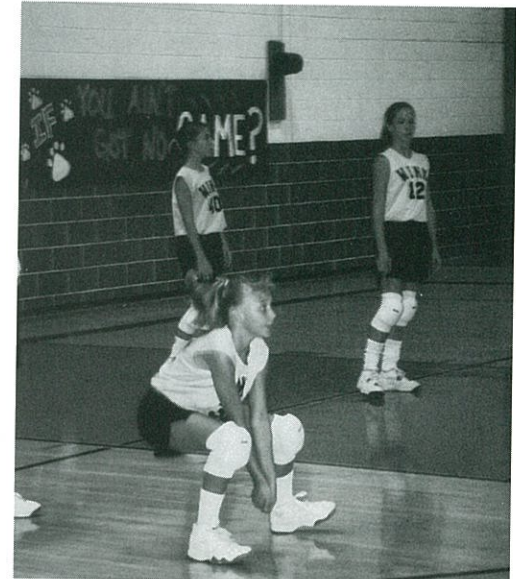


Hoping to win another game, Eighth grader Keli Gunn practices her passing during a pregame warm-up.

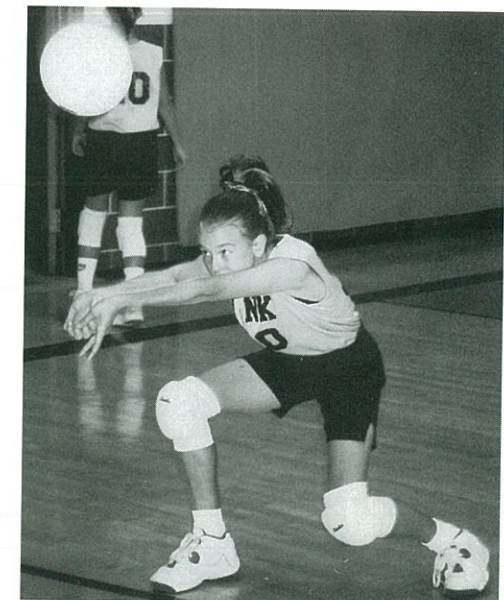
