Seventh grader Gil Shackelford leaps a hurdle on his way to, beating all opponents during the district track meet.

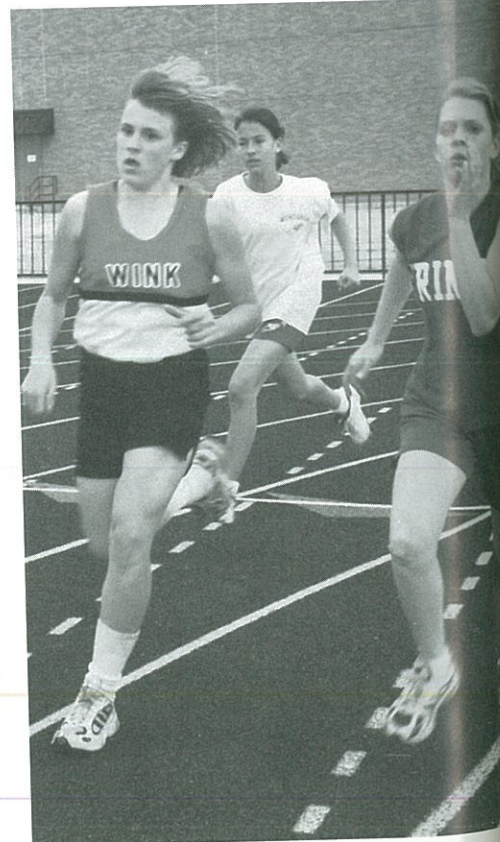

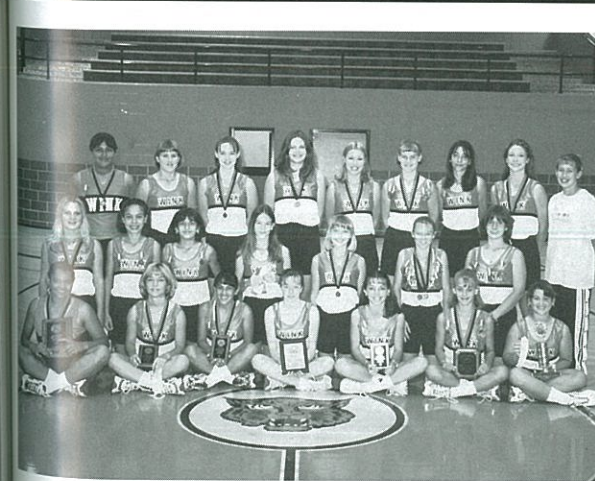
Eighth grader Bear Haring and seventh grader Terry Rich give their best track and field effort at the Wildcat Relays.
