

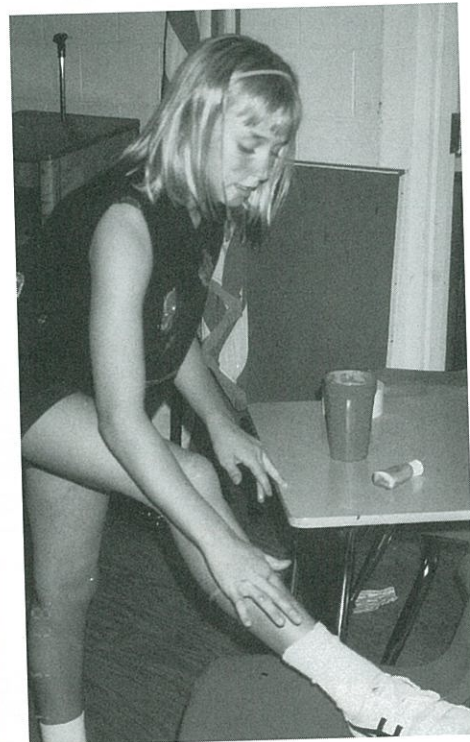
GO CATS GO!

Eighth grader Ella Fernandes prances after a Wildcat touchdown.

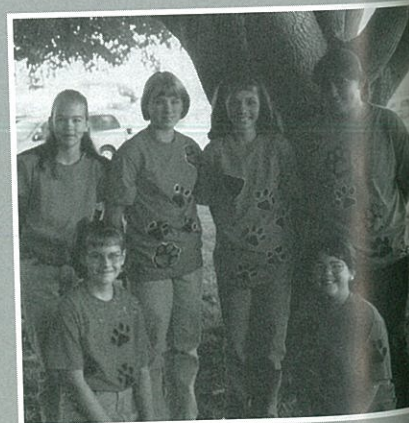


A TIME TO CHEER!!!

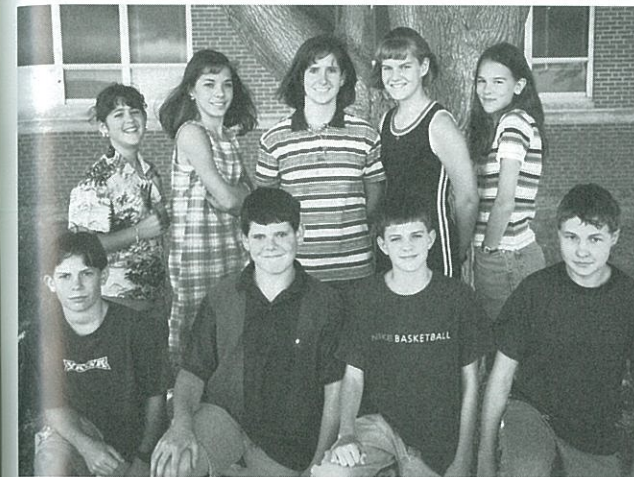

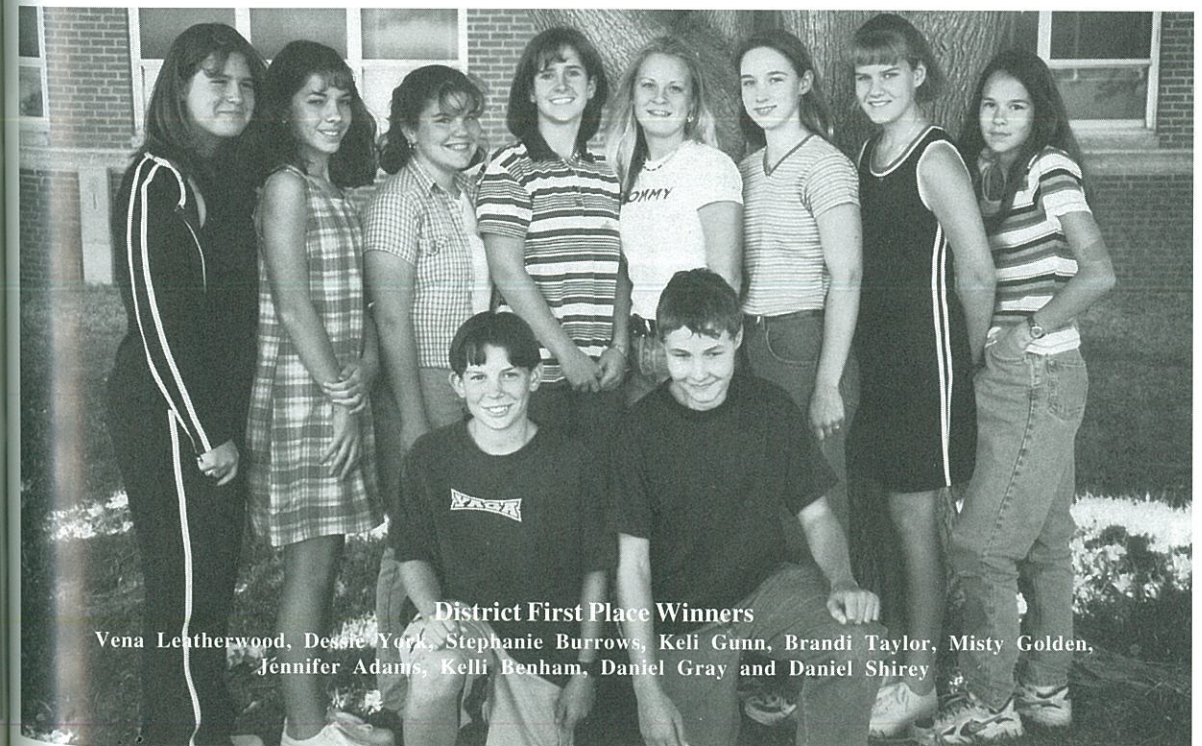
District UIL Champions: Team scores 498 points for overwhelming victory
