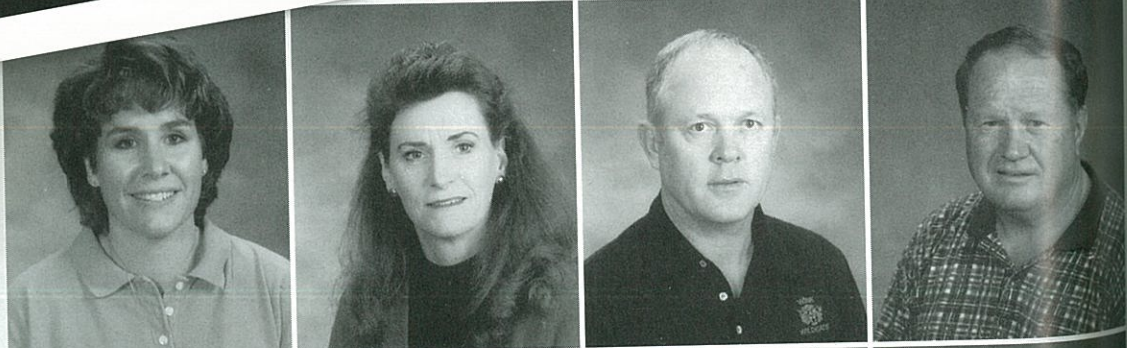

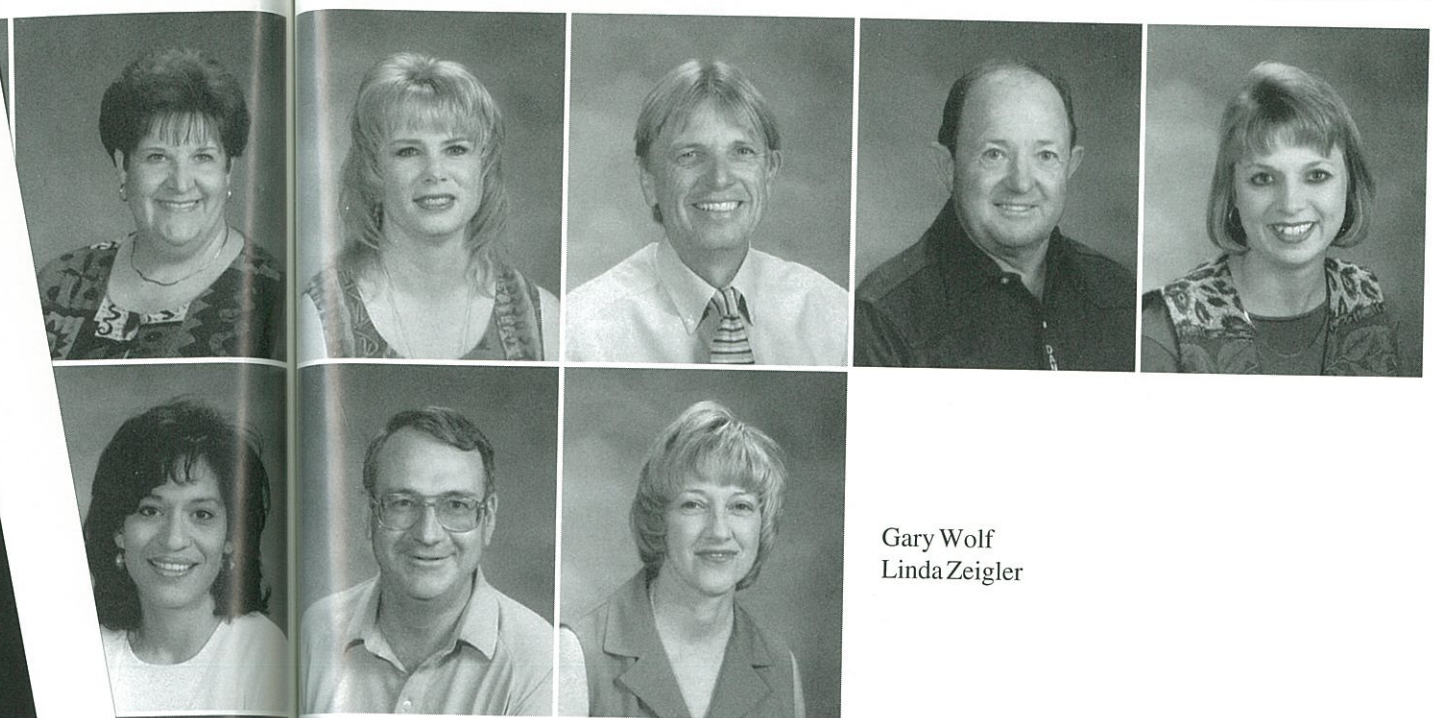

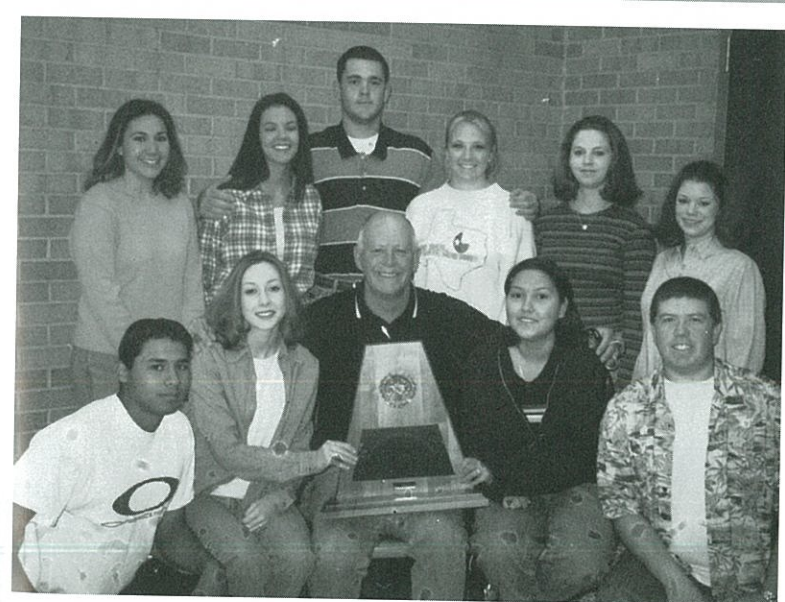
Band director Tom Burns leaves WHS after nine years of supreme success
