
At the close of football off-season drills and a quick track work-out, junior Clayton Hawkins goes to the tennis courts to practice for the district tennis meet.

The varsity girls basketball team celebrates winning their bi-district against Sierra Blanca. The girls posted a record of 18-6 under Coach Kent Josselet.






