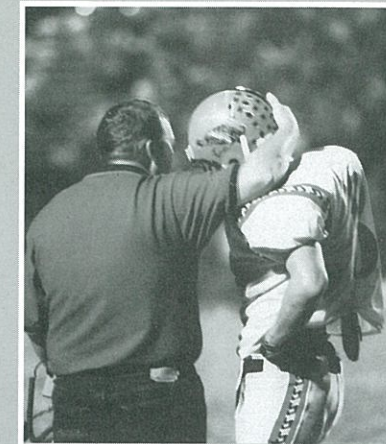

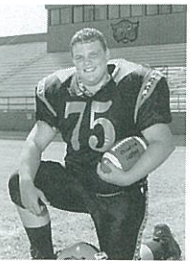

Coach Randy Tankersley goes over game strategy with junior fullback/linebacker Weldon Thompson as he (Thompson) takes a quick breather during a change of possession.

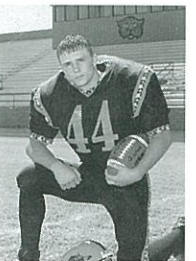
