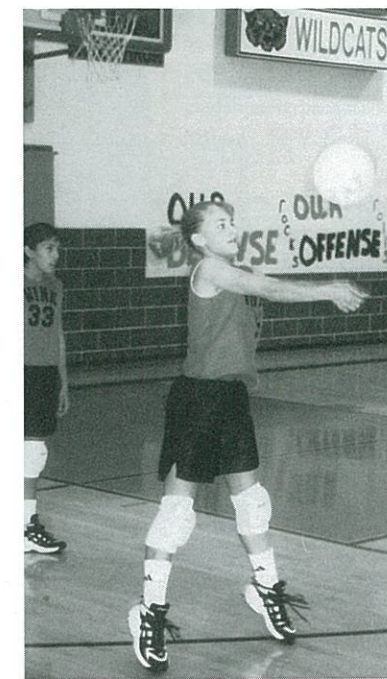
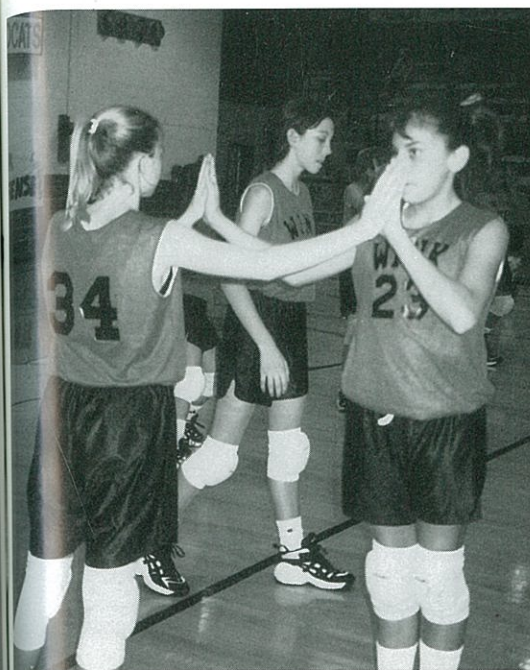
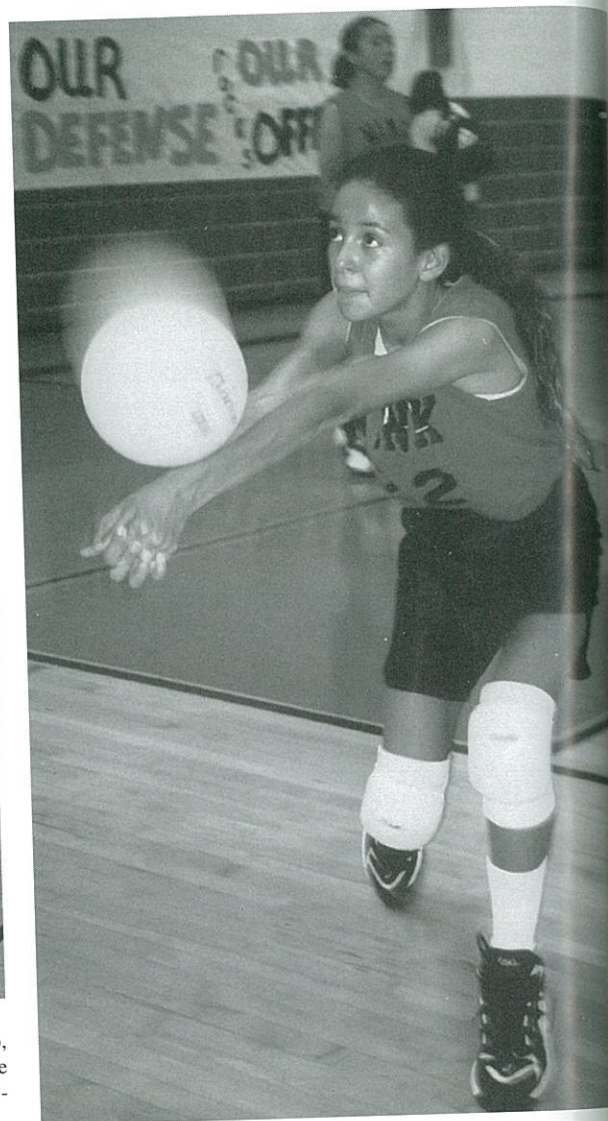
Junior high teams post winning records
