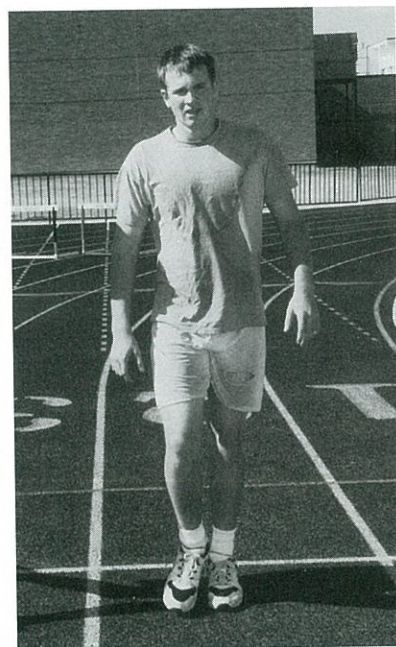
## Junior High Track District Champs

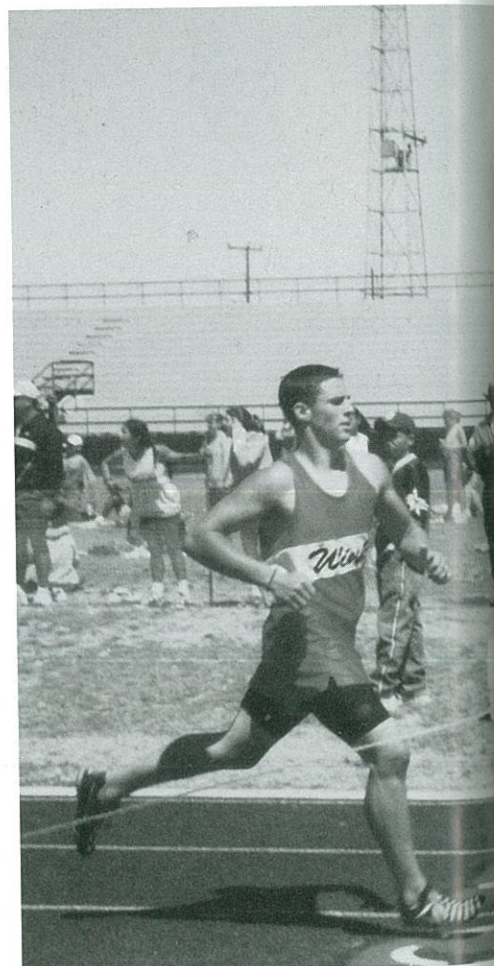
