a family affair

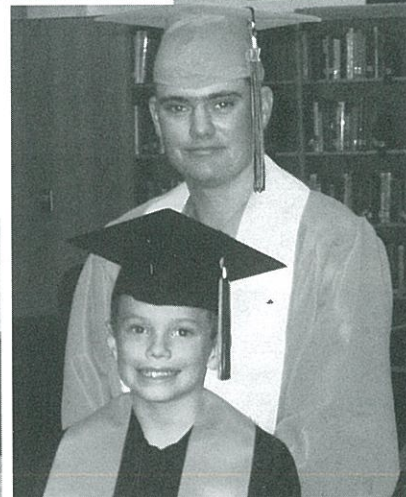

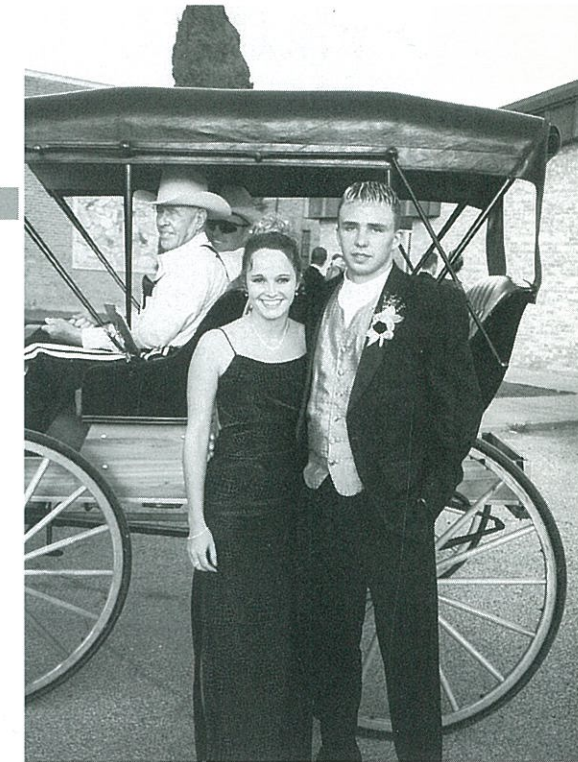
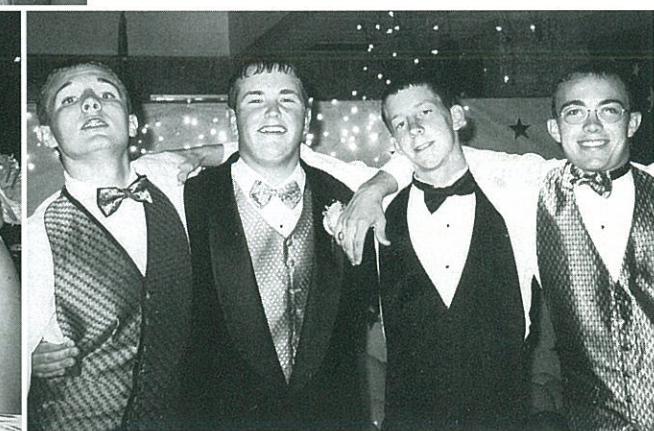
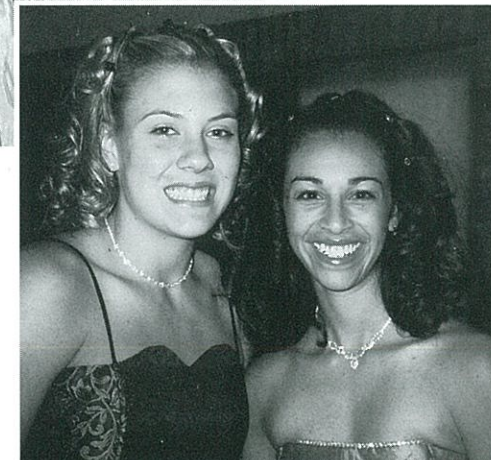
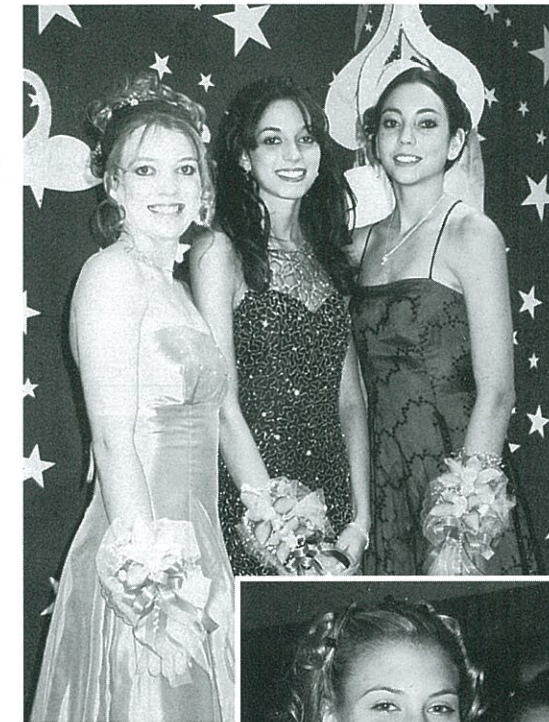
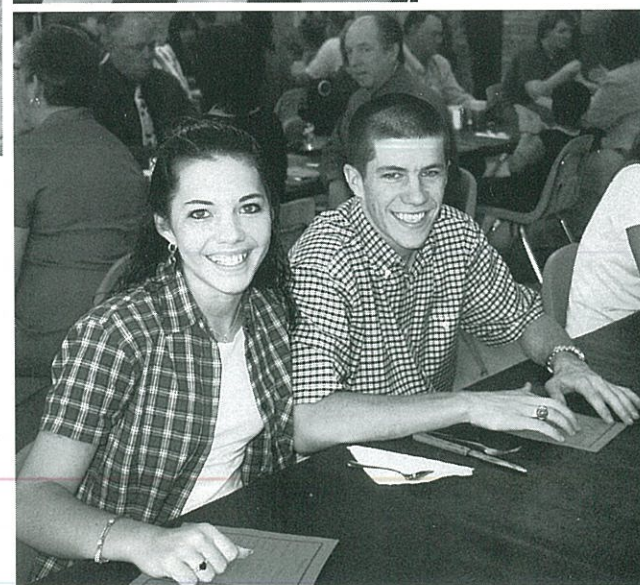
Campus favorites, Pam and Ron Cohea, work together keeping the books and clock during a basketball tournament.
