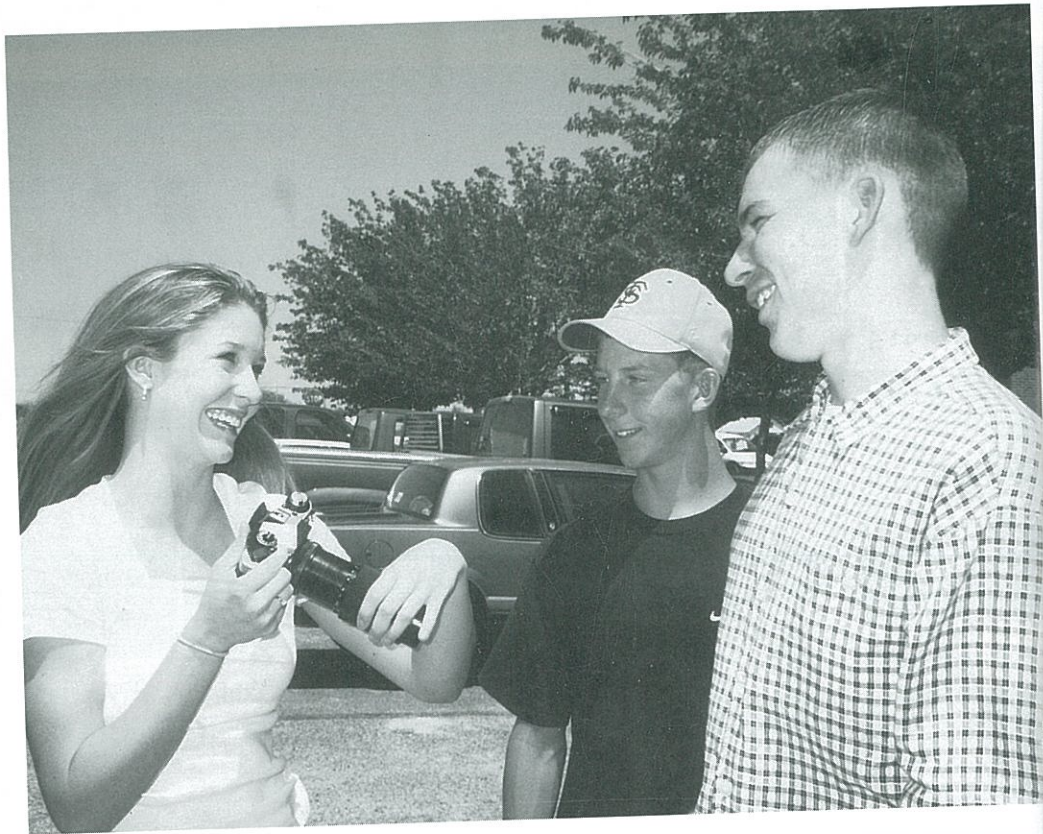


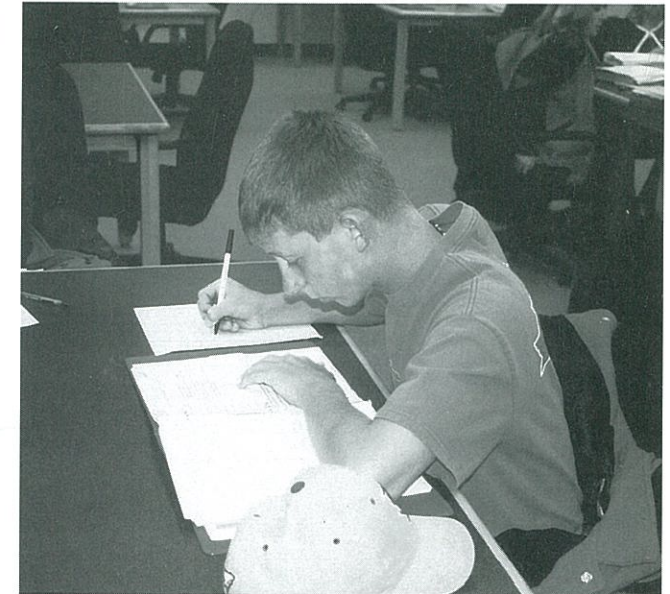

# ACTIVITIES

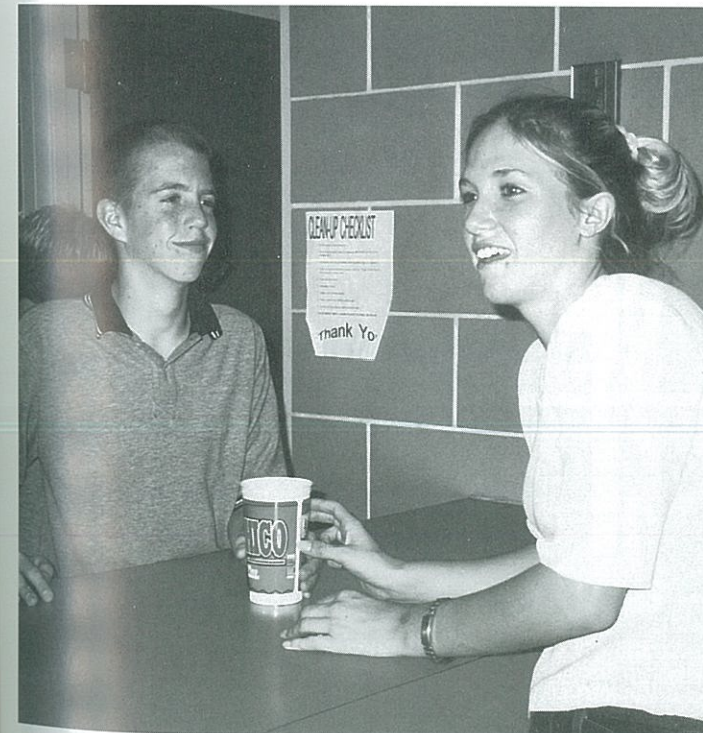
