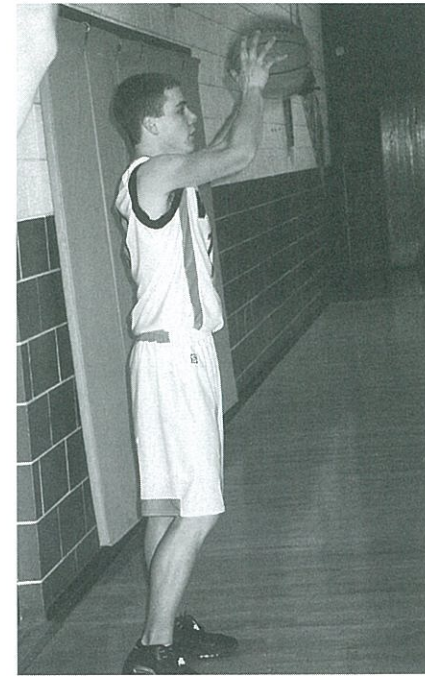

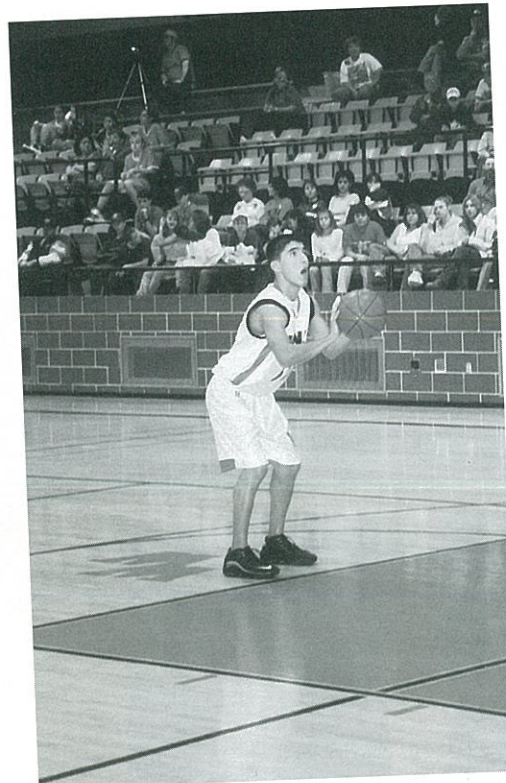

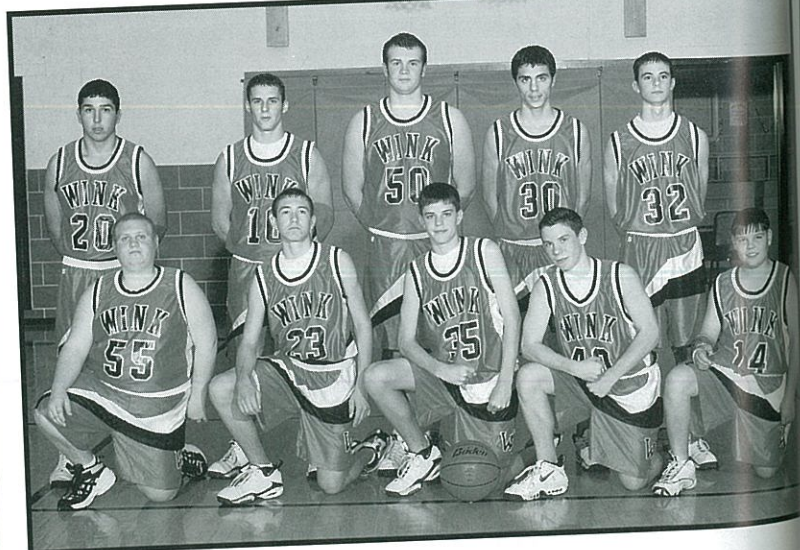


Senior Eathan Hamm, a second team all-district selection, used his superior ball handling and passing ability to lead the Wildcats with 124 assists

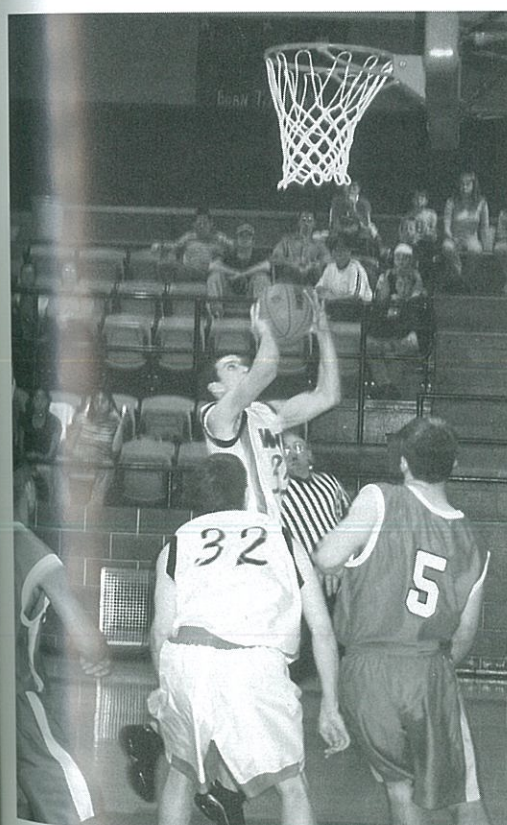

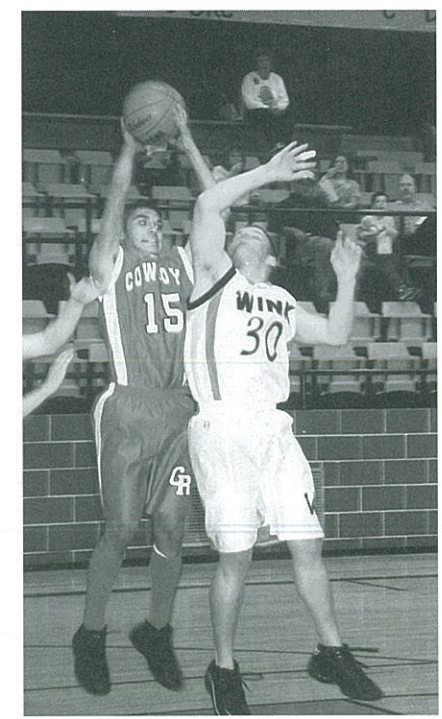
