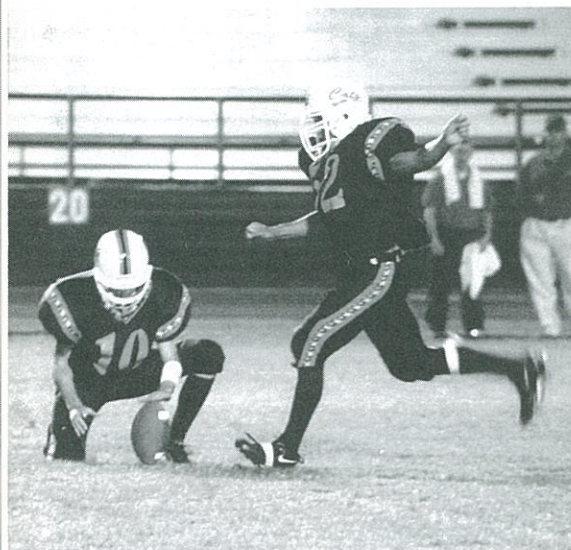


Blazing with intensity

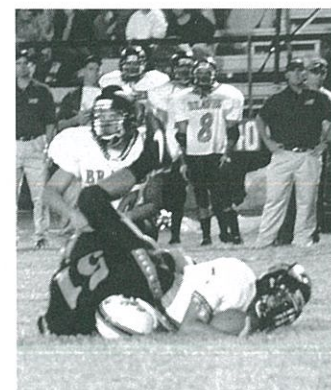

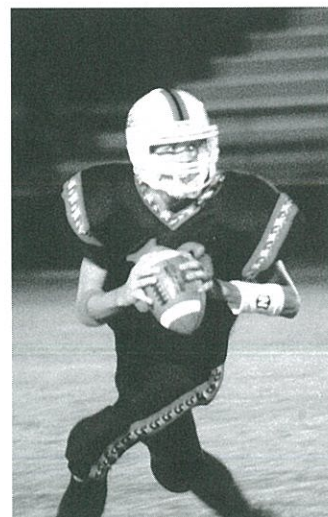

Seniors Clay Haws, Raudell Villalpando, and O'Ryan White walk out just minutes before a game to meet with captains of the opposing team for the coin toss.

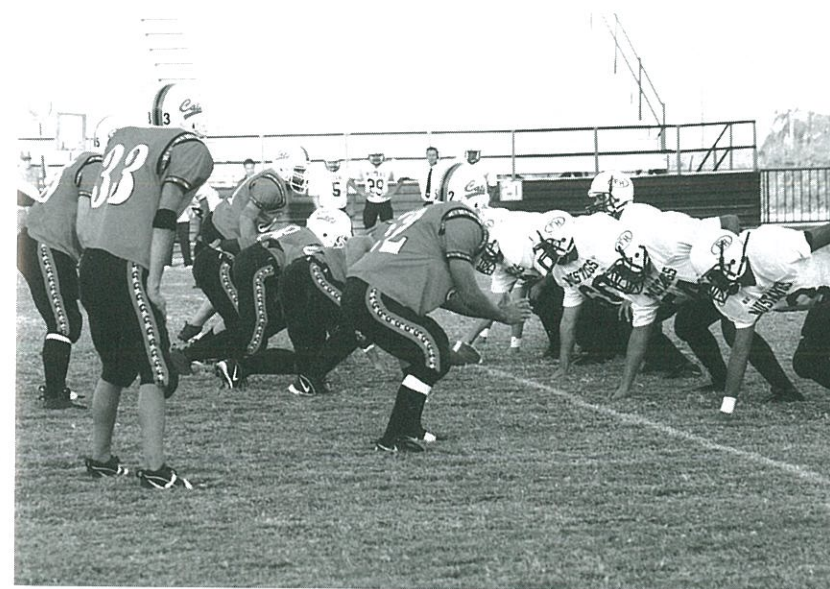


Junior Daniel Gray prevents a touchdown by tackling Iraan's Jared Jennings. Daniel was a second team all-district defensive end selection.
