*they return home*

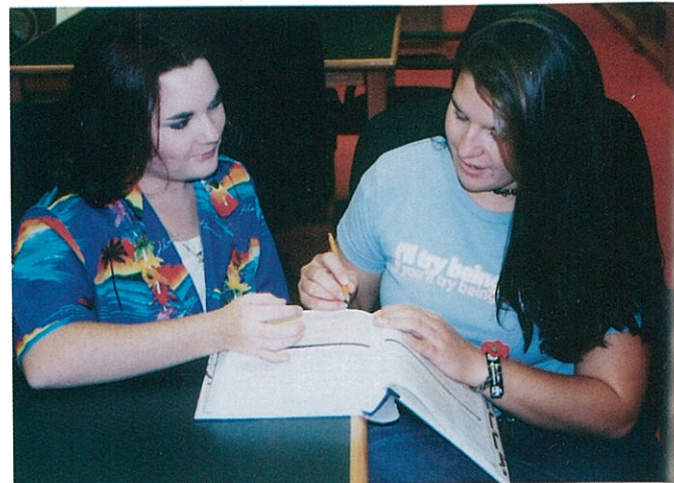
stay busy

burning daylight

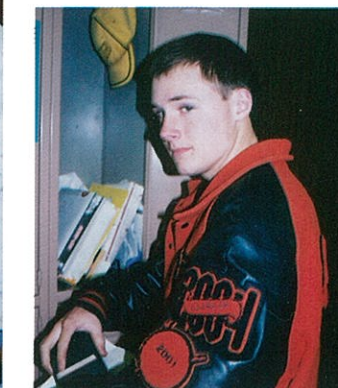

Senior Rhonda Bingham and junior Vena Leatherwood put their heads together to figure out a physics equation.



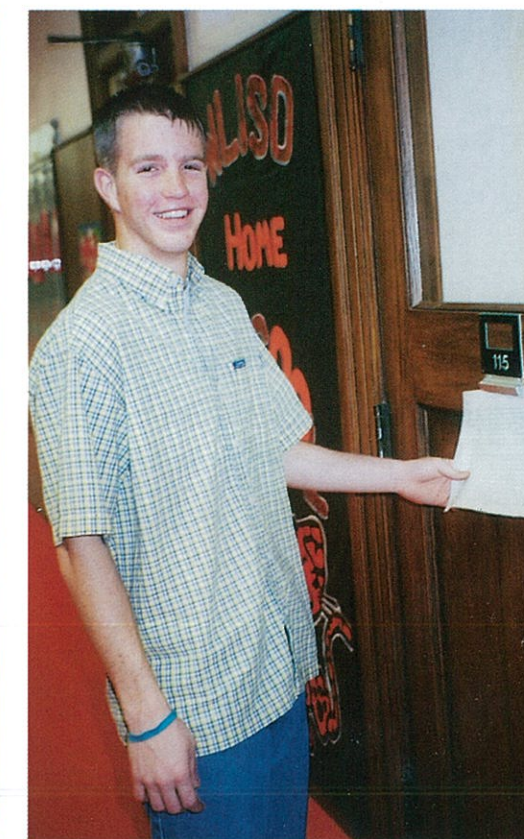
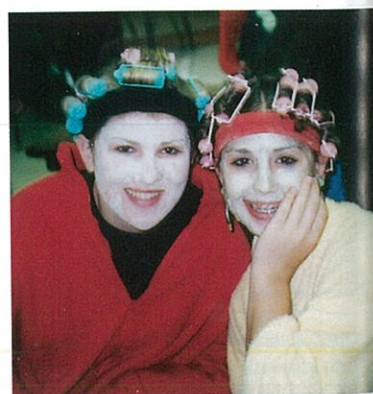
