


Is Jessica Youngblood fed up with the dress code? No. She is in costume to shoot a mock commercial as part of a assignment in English class.

Is Scott Rossell destroying incriminating evidence? No. As the yearbook staff's most experienced photographer, he's preparing for another shoot.




