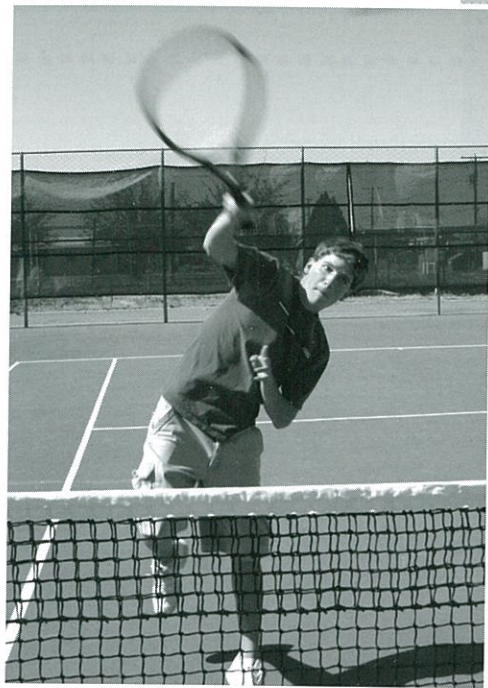


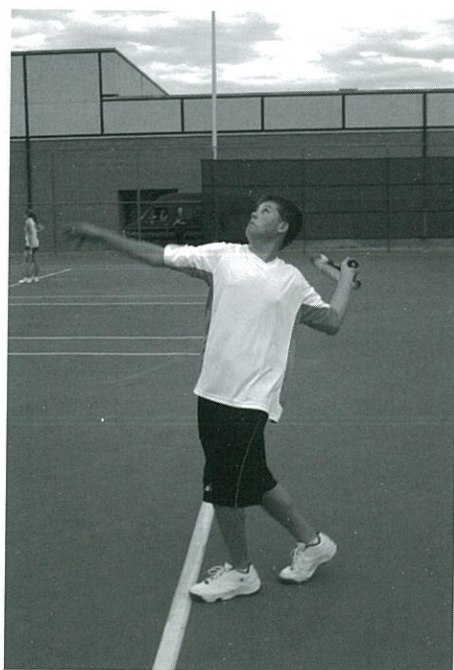
Cats find success on courts

Sophomores Kevin McGehee and Robbie Sellers paired up for district and placed second in boys doubles to advance to regional for the first time.



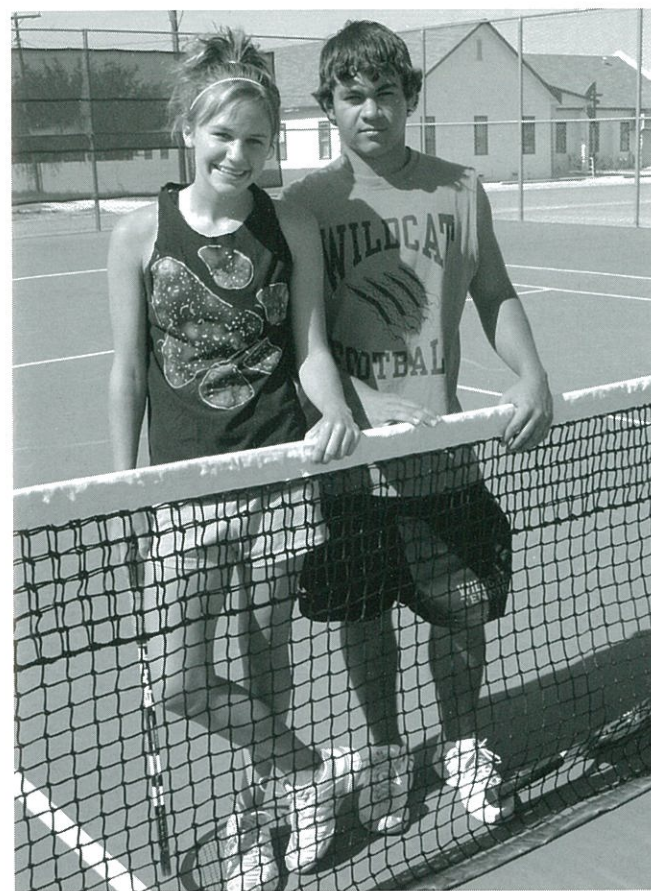
The doubles team of Ashley Raska and Jasmine Solis made a fine showing at the District 8A Tournament by finishing third in girls doubles.

Tennis mixed-doubles became a UIL spring athletic event for the first time in 2006, and freshman Andra Kerley and senior Chris Lujan took full advantage and became the first Wink tennis players to reach State since 1982, by placing second at the Region I Tournament. Once in Austin, the team defeated Miles and D'Hannis to find themselves face-to-face with their nemesis from regional, the mixed-doubles duo from Nazareth. The powerful Nazareth team once again won the gold, but not until they had taken everything Kerley and Lujan could throw at them. The Wink team fought long and hard before falling 6-4; 6-3.
