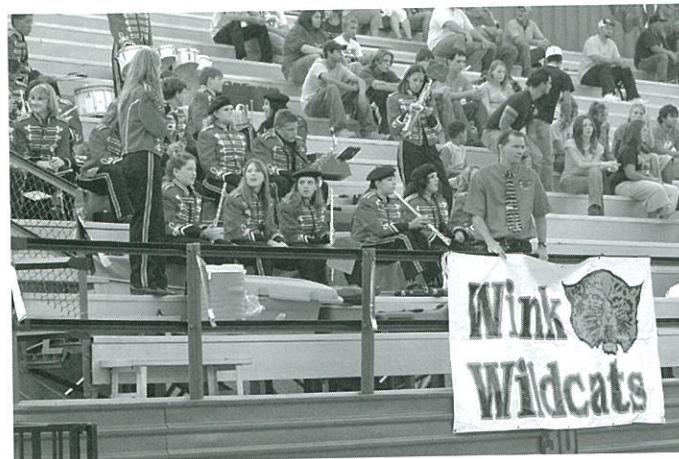


WE'RE BACK!

BAND EARNS DIVISION I RATING AT UIL CONTEST

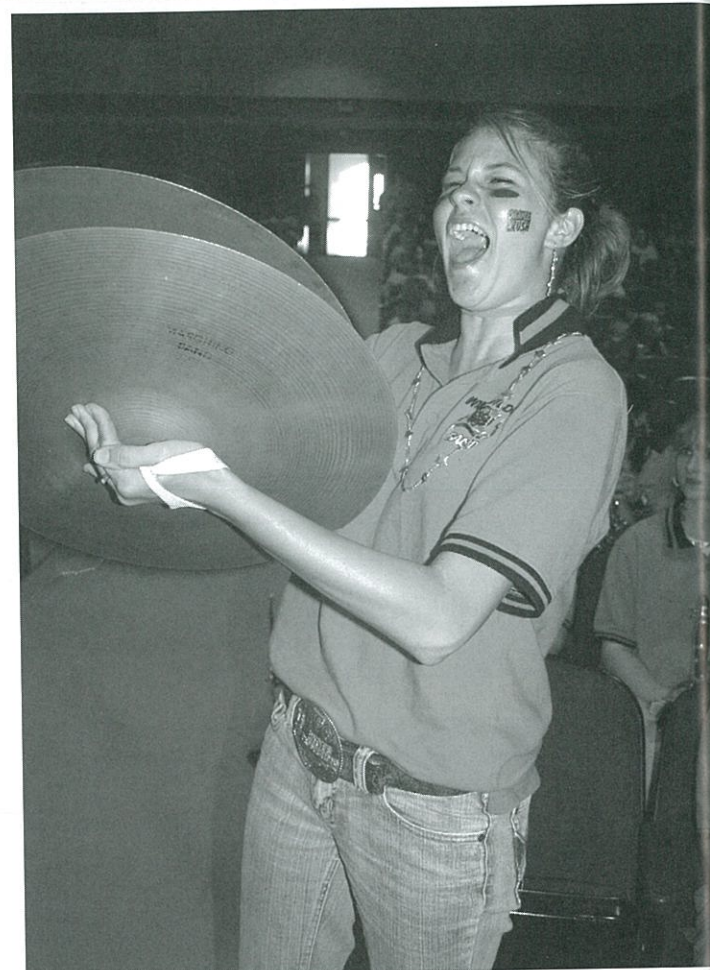


The band gathers behind their banner just prior to the opening kick-off of the first game of the season.

Senior Dominick Chaves makes some noise for the Lady Cats send-off to the Region I Volleyball Tournament.

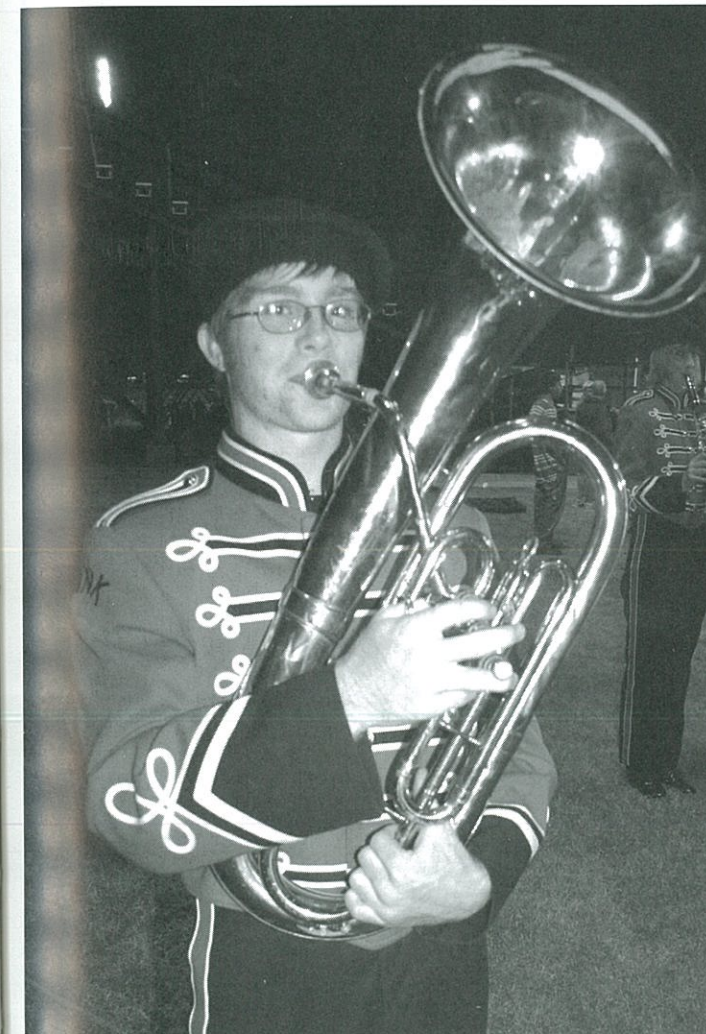

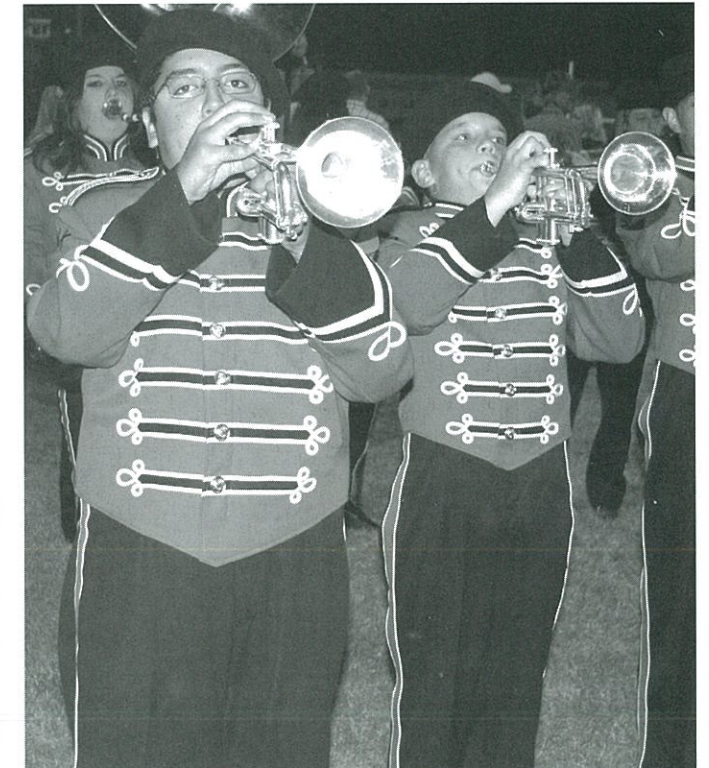
