Taryn Curtis, Kristen Boggess and Andra Kerley take the first turn at the Wink meet.

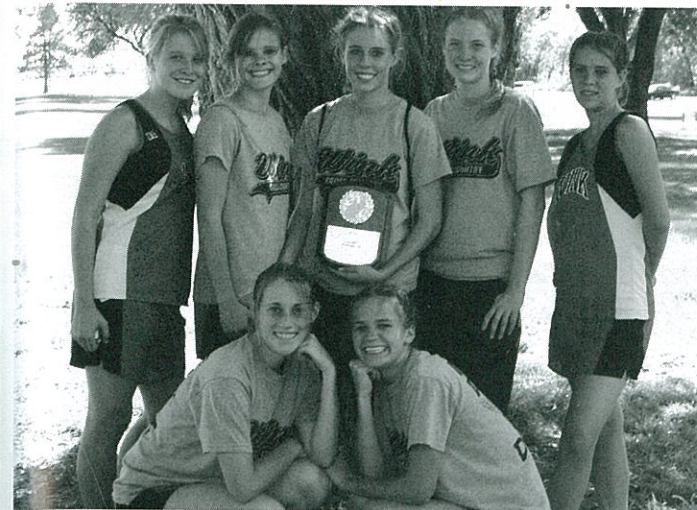
Sophomore, Keshia Sellers, ran her best time of the season, 13:29, at Lamesa.

Kristen Boggess runs at the Wink meet. Her best time was a 14:06.



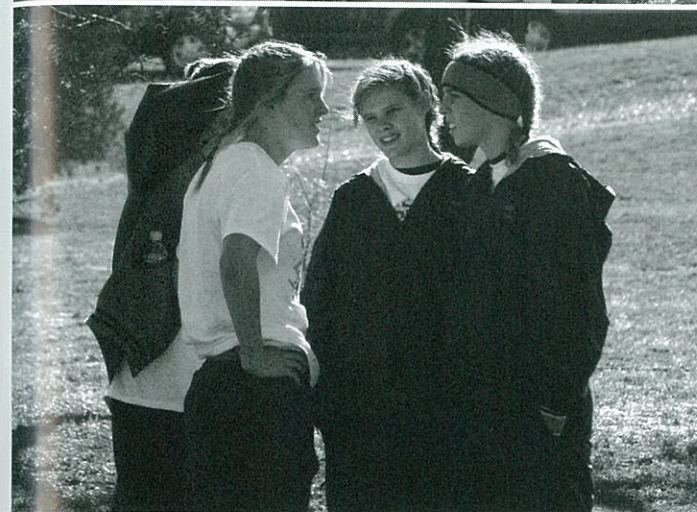
The Lady Cats display their second place plaque that they received at the district meet held in Lamesa.

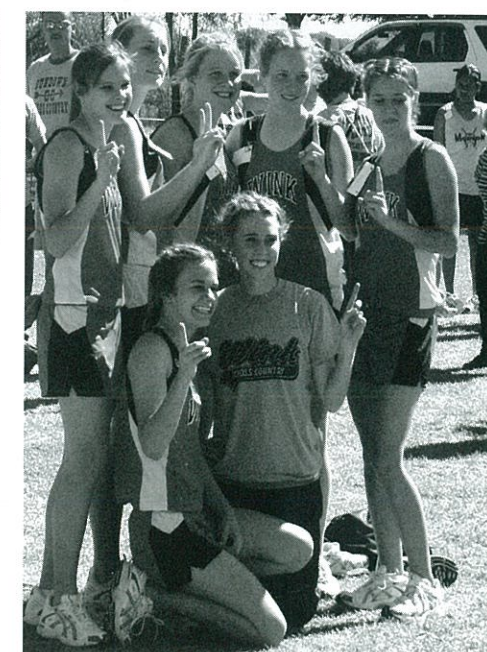
