

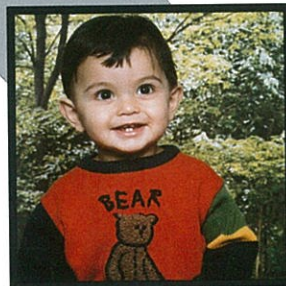
## DEREK FOSTEL

As you go off to college, always trust in yourself, your family, and your faith.

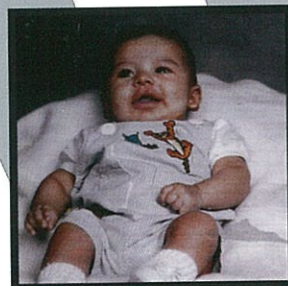

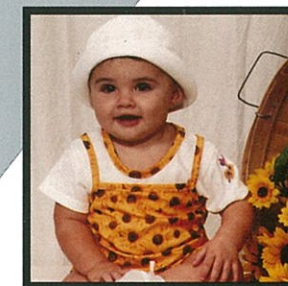
